East Wesley Streetscape



Construction Nearing Completion!

June 18, 2007

The Department of Public Works is implementing streetscape improvement along East Wesley Road from Peachtree Street to Piedmont Avenue, located in Council District 7. This project was discussed, studied and designed, at the request of the Garden Hills neighborhood in an effort to alleviate traffic safety concerns.

Description:

The project scope includes but is not limited to, installation of new sidewalk on the north side of the road, curb revisions with bulb-outs, median work, crosswalks, drainage installation, wheelchair ramps for handicap access, selective asphalt work, pavement markings and signage, and landscaping. The length of the project is approximately 1.26 miles. The project is nearing completion.

Key Design Elements Include:

- Narrowing of roadway and some median work
- Six foot wide sidewalks with header curb and grass strip with tree landscape
- Upgrading of the intersections to ADA compliance requirements
- Landscaped median
- Pedestrian crosswalks

Funding/Cost:

\$1.3M, CMAQ (Congestion, Mitigation, & Air Quality) 80%, Local Funds (Quality of Life & Impact Fees) 20%

Construction/Activity Schedule week of June 18, 2007:

The contractor is currently providing minor detail work along East Wesley Road this week. Landscaping activities are continuing along with milling activities which have begun to allow for resurfacing of the roadway. Additional curbing may be installed at the intersection of East Wesley & Ellwood Drive dependent upon the completion of milling activities in this location. The public is reminded to exercise caution when traversing construction areas.

Note: Construction activities are estimated and may be subject to change.
