



# Cascade Road – Phase 1 Streetscape Improvement Project

November 29, 2006

The City of Atlanta Department of Public Works is pleased to announce the completion of Phase 1 of streetscape improvements along Cascade Road, Council District 11.



Cascade Road Streetscape Improvements

## Description

Early October 2004, we began installing new sidewalks, driveway aprons, crosswalks, and pedestrian lights along both sides of Cascade Road. The project limits extend from the Northern Leg of Willis Mill Road and conclude at Venetian Drive, SW, Council District 11.

This project was completed mid February 2005.

## Project Funding

The funding sources used were approximately \$300,000 Federal Funds (Transportation Enhancement), and approximately \$330,000 Local Funds (Quality of Life Bond Program).

## Status

The construction of this project is complete. There are a few minor remaining items to be completed within the next couple of weeks such as the removal of the old utility poles, the replacement of a pedestrian light fixture, and the relocation of a few street signs.

## Additional Project Information

Phase 1 of the Cascade/B.E. Mays Streetscape project is a prototype of other proposed projects along Cascade Road which are anticipated to create a more walkable community. Streetscape enhancements are planned at the intersection of Cascade Road and Benjamin E. Mays Drive, SW. (Phase II) and along Cascade Road from Venetian to Beecher/Rio Grande (Phase III).
