Description: The Greenbriar Livable Center Improvement Project will seek to improve pedestrian access and safety issues, as well as upgrade and enhance the existing streetscape elements as follows:

- Langford Parkway to I-285: Streetscape improvements from SR. 166 to I-285 bridge including pedestrian lights, new sidewalk, street trees and benches.

Funding: Local (construction) - \$ 381,600 Quality of Life
LCI (design) \$95,000, (construction) \$1,526,400

- Barge Road/Campbellton Rd. Intersection: Intersection improvement & new sidewalk.

Funding: Local (design) \$64,000, (construction) \$100,000 Quality of Life
LCI (design) \$16,000, (construction) \$224,000

- Langford Parkway & Campbellton Road Intersection: Intersection improvement including realignment of Campbellton Road.

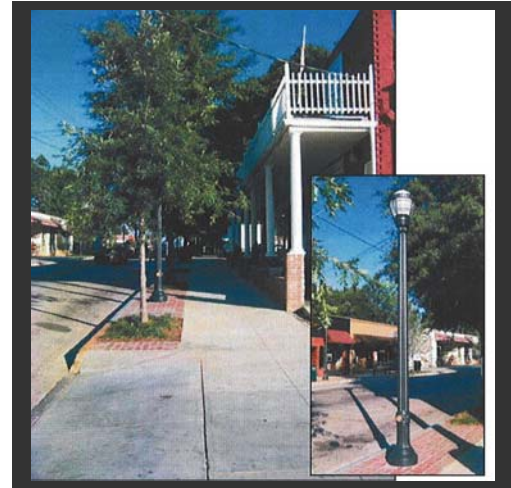
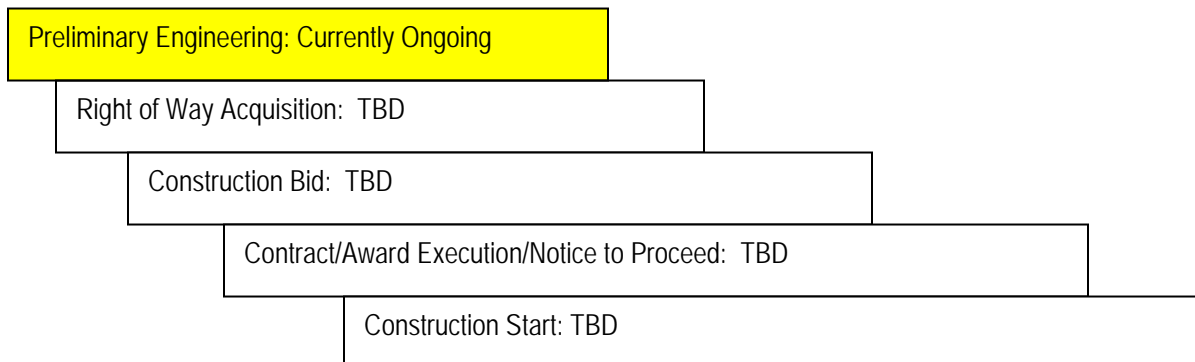
Funding: Local (design) - \$ 120,000, Quality of Life
LCI (design) - \$30,000

- Headland Drive: Streetscape improvements from Greenbriar Parkway to City Limits; including pedestrian lights, new sidewalk, street trees and benches.

Funding: Local (design) - \$ 40,000, (construction) \$100,000, Quality of Life
LCI (design) - \$10,000, (construction) \$200,000

Status: Concept is approved. Preliminary engineering underway.
