


### CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU Q: 2010 POPULATION


According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) Q is 2,036, an increase of 1,012 (99%) from a 2000 population of 1,024.

The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU Q. NPU Q had an overall density of 2.7 persons per acre.
















### **HOUSEHOLDS**




There are 2,036 NPU Q residents in 742 households. Of these, 78% are family households and 22% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 37% have children under age 18 and 25% have an individual 65 years and older.

19% percent of households are single person households, with 17% being single person households over 65, 18% are female headed households and 57% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.74 persons per household and the average family size is 3.11 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 403 households in NPU Q, 36% had children under age 18 and 30% were single person households. The average household size was 2.54 persons per household.


# 2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU Q


