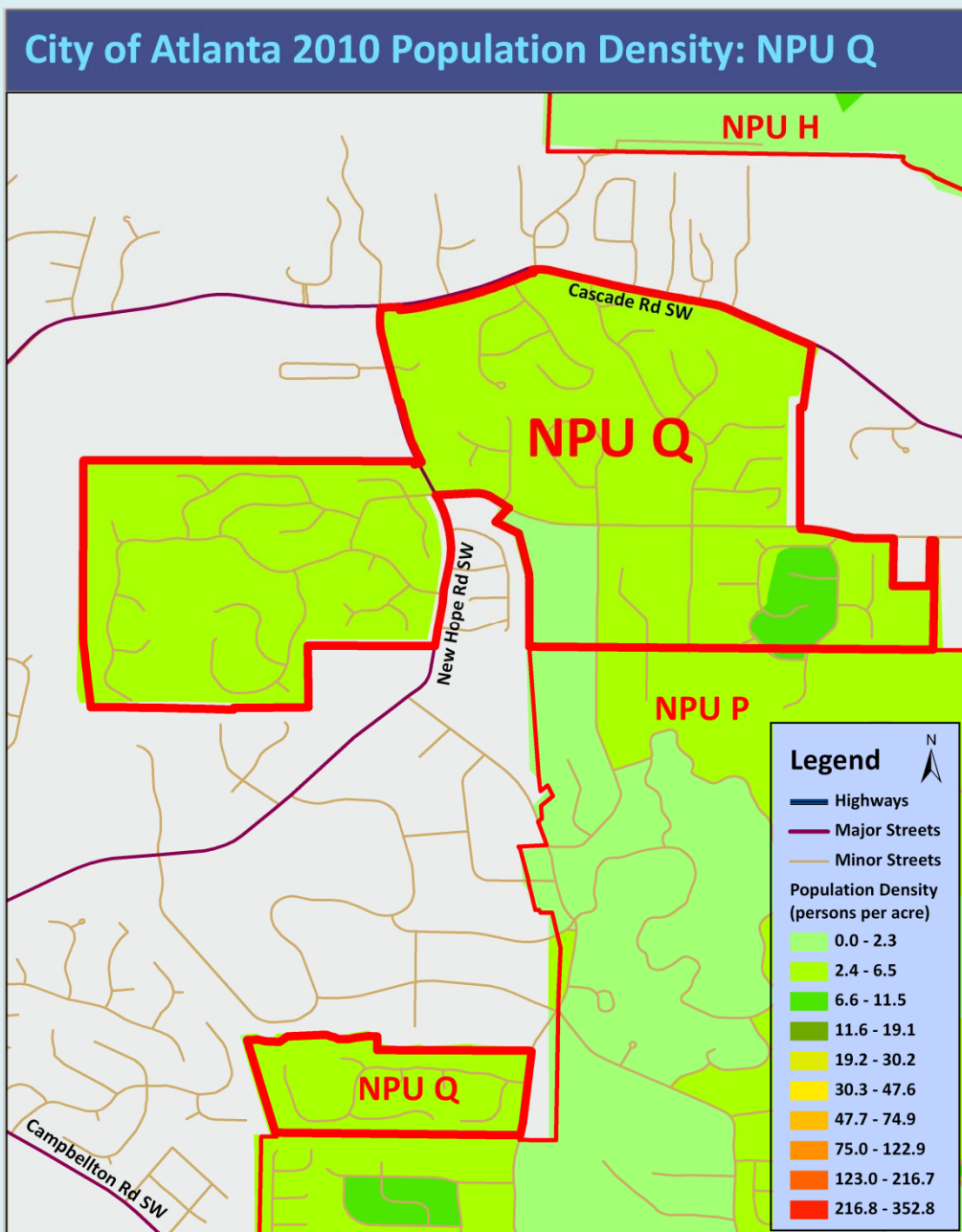

CITY OF ATLANTA – NPU Q: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) Q is 2,036, an increase of 1,012 (99%) from a 2000 population of 1,024.

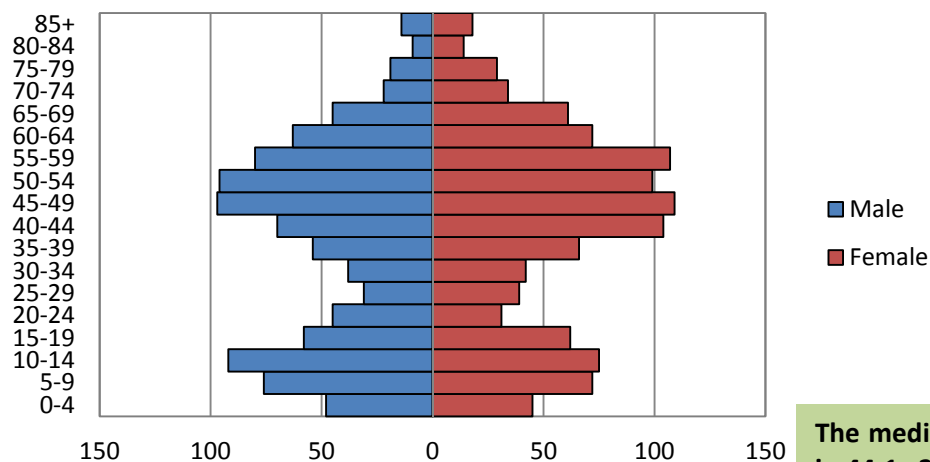
The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU Q. NPU Q had an overall density of 2.7 persons per acre.

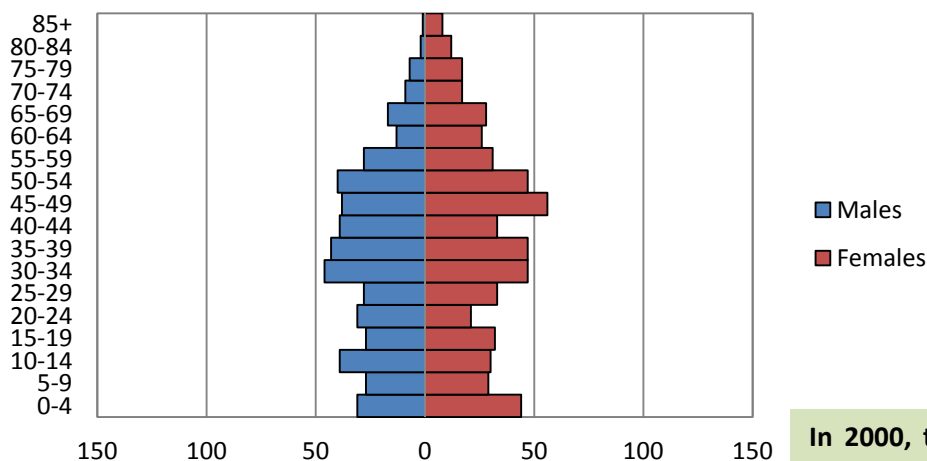

2010 Age Population Pyramid - NPU Q



The median age of the population is 44.1. 25% of the population is under 18, 17% of the population is over 65 and 23% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.

2000 Age Population Pyramid - NPU Q

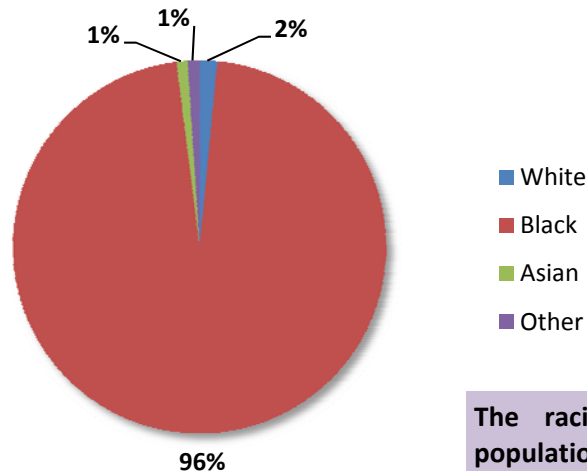


In 2000, the median age was 38. 12% of the population was over 65, and 29% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.



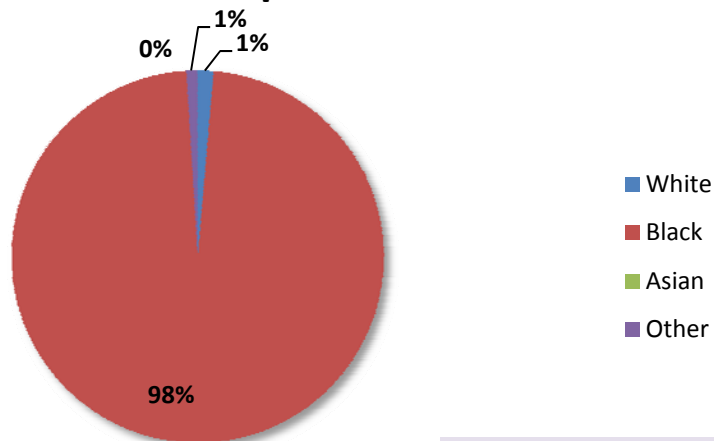
RACE

2010 Racial Composition - NPU Q



The racial composition of the NPU Q population is 96% Black, 2% White, 1% Asian, and 1% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, other race and two or more races). 1% of the population is of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

2000 Racial Composition - NPU Q



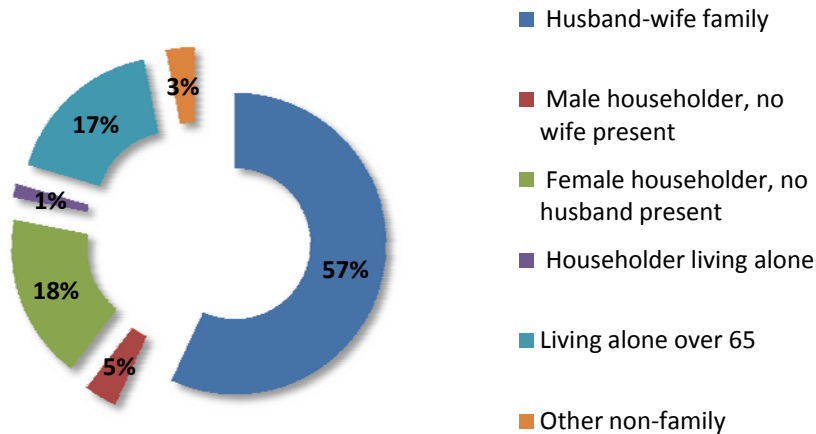
In 2000, the racial composition of NPU Q was 98% Black, 1% White, 0% Asian and 2% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other race). 1% of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

2010 Household Composition - NPU Q



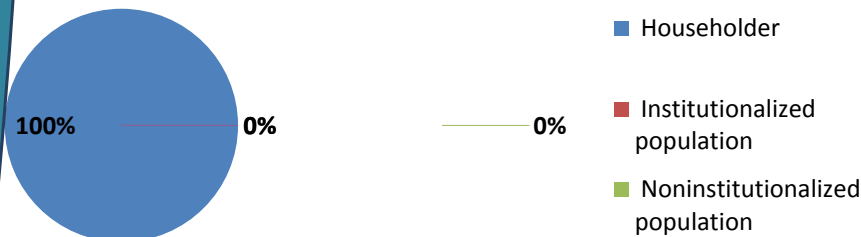
There are 2,036 NPU Q residents in 742 households. Of these, 78% are family households and 22% are non-family households. Of all households, 37% have children under age 18 and 25% have an individual 65 years and older.

19% percent of households are single person households, with 17% being single person households over 65, 18% are female headed households and 57% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.74 persons per household and the average family size is 3.11 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 403 households in NPU Q, 36% had children under age 18 and 30% were single person households. The average household size was 2.54 persons per household.

2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU Q

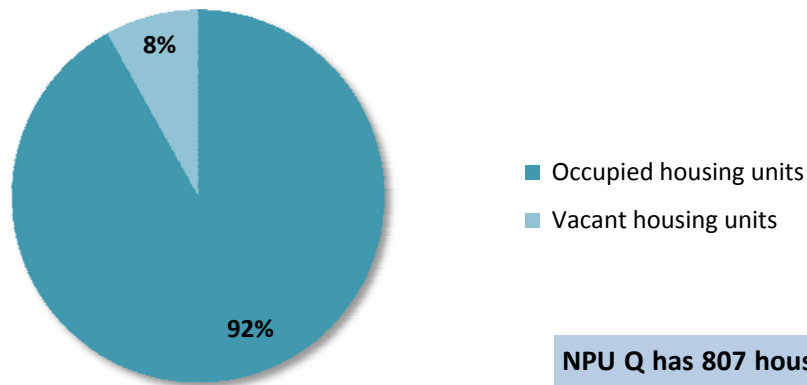


100% of the NPU Q population lives in households.



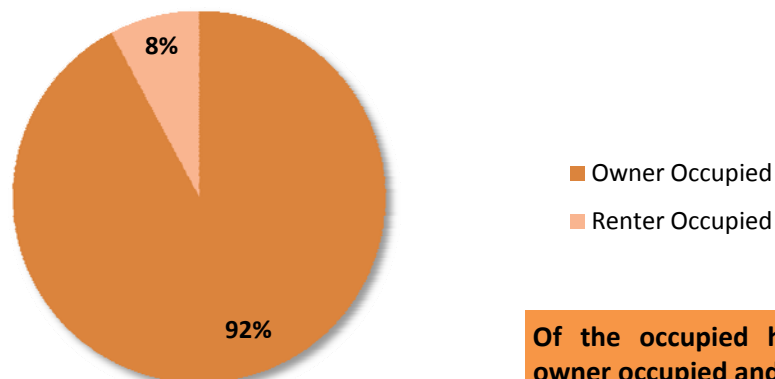

2010 Housing Occupancy - NPU Q



NPU Q has 807 housing units, an increase of 399 units (98%) from 408 in 2000. 92% are occupied and 8% are vacant. Rental units have 12% vacancy rate while owner occupied units have a 3% vacancy rate.

2010 Housing Tenure - NPU Q



Of the occupied housing units, 92% are owner occupied and 8% are renter occupied. In 2000, 82% of housing units were owner occupied and 18% were renter occupied.

Renter occupied units have a smaller household size (2.7) than owner occupied units (3.3).
