


CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU O: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) O is 13,806, a decrease of 918 (6%) from a 2000 population of 14,724.


The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU O. NPU O has an overall density of 6.3 persons per acre.


The median age of the population is 34.7. 19% of the population is under 18, 11% of the population is over 65 and 40% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.




In 2000, NPU O had a median age of 34. 12% of the population was over 65 and 31% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.








There are 13,777 NPU O residents in 6,236 households. Of these, 49% are family households and 51% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 24% have children under age 18 and 20% have an individual 65 years and older.

36% of households are single person households, with 11% being single person households over 65, 20% are female headed households and 25% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.21 persons per household and the average family size is 2.96 persons per family.


In 2000, of the 5,363 households in NPU O, 34% had children under age 18 and 29% were single person households. The average household size was 2.73 persons per household.




100% of the NPU O population lives in households, 29 live in group quarters.
