

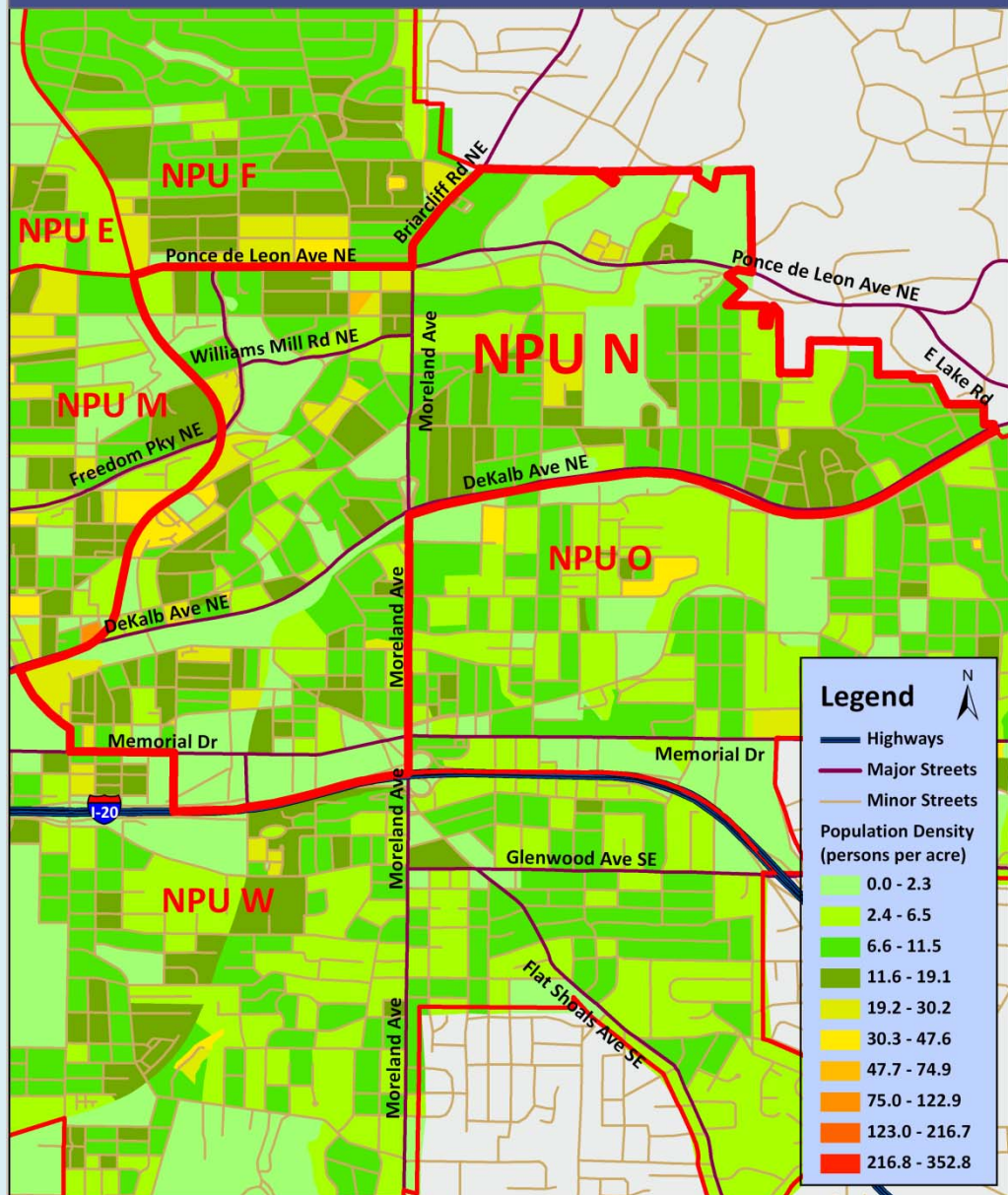

CITY OF ATLANTA – NPU N: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) N is 17,385, an increase of 2,697 (18%) from a 2000 population of 14,688.

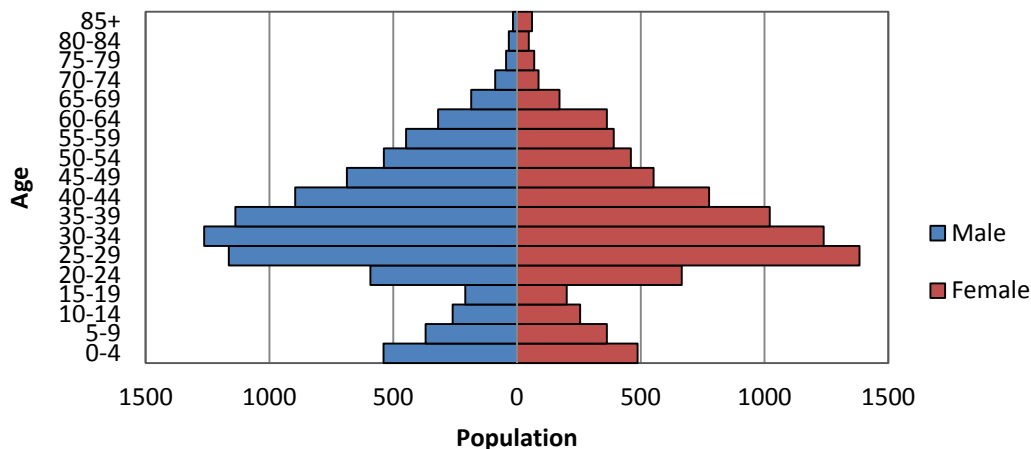
The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU N. NPU N has an overall density of 7.9 persons per acre.

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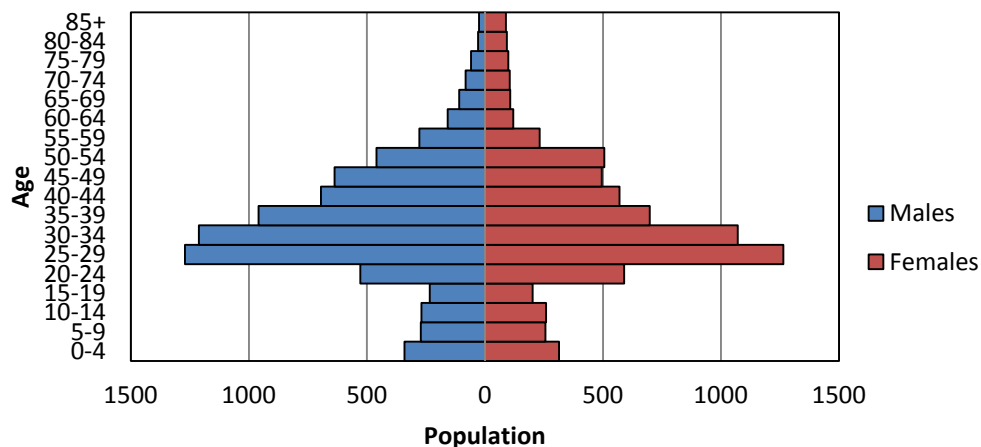

2010 Population Pyramid - NPU N



NPU N's population median age of is 34.4. 14% of the population is under 18, 5% of the population is over 65 and 49% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.

2000 Population Pyramid - NPU N



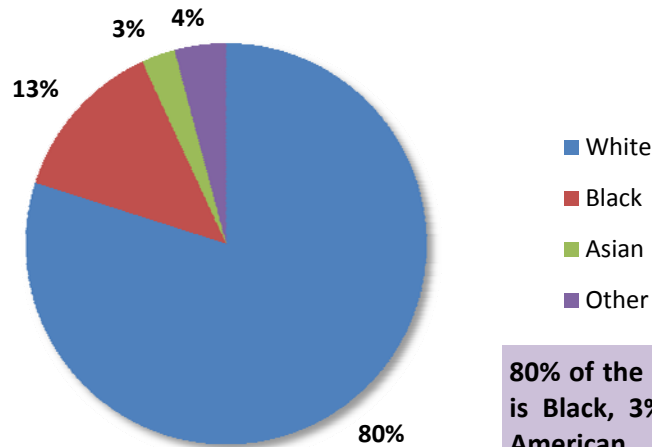
In 2000, NPU N had a median age of 33.4. 5% of the population was over 65, and 52% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.

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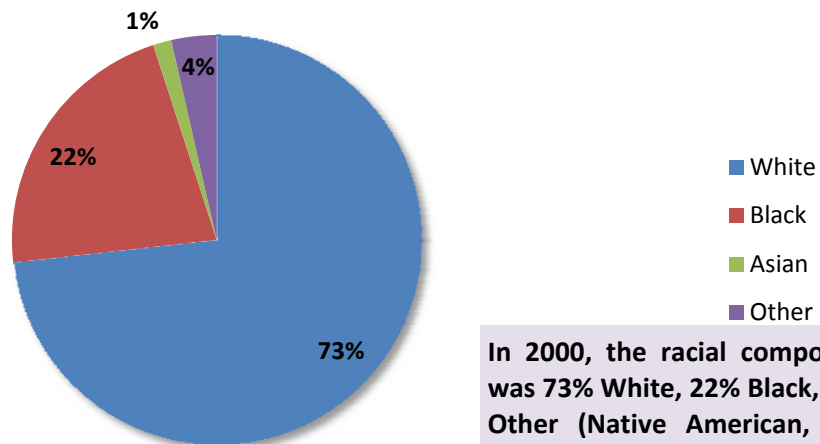
RACE

2010 Racial Composition - NPU N



80% of the NPU N population is White, 13% is Black, 3% is Asian, 4% is other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other). 4% of the population is of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

2000 Racial Composition - NPU N



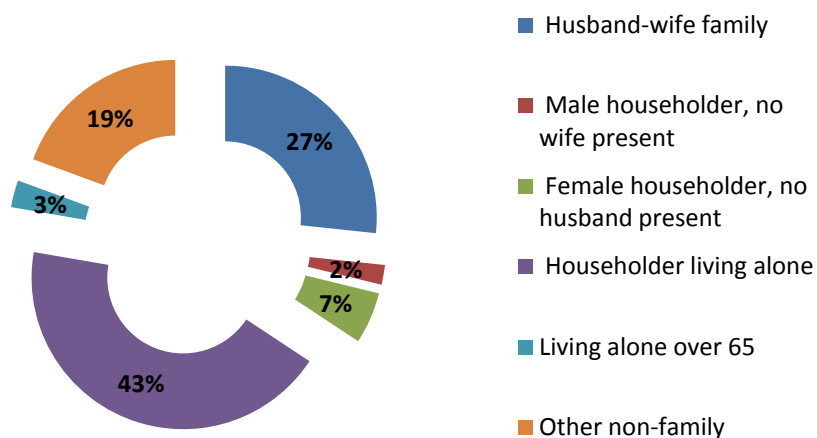
In 2000, the racial composition of NPU N was 73% White, 22% Black, 1% Asian and 4% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other). 3% of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

2010 Household Composition - NPU N



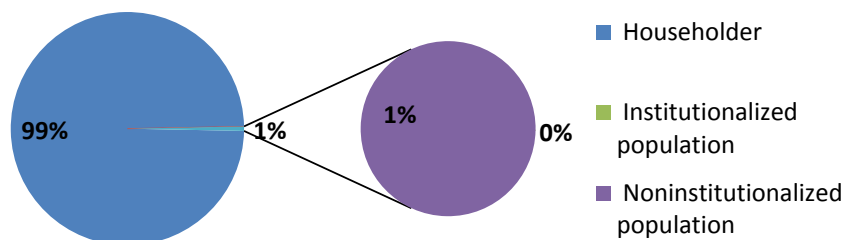
There are 17,385 NPU N residents in 9,220 households. Of these, 34% are family households and 66% are non-family households. Of all households, 17% have children under age 18 and 7% have an individual 65 years and older.

46% of households are single person households, with 3% being single person households over 65, 6% are female headed households and 27% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 1.87 persons per household and the average family size is 2.77 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 7,708 households in NPU N, 15% had children under age 18 and 46% were single person households. The average household size was 1.90 persons per household.

2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU N

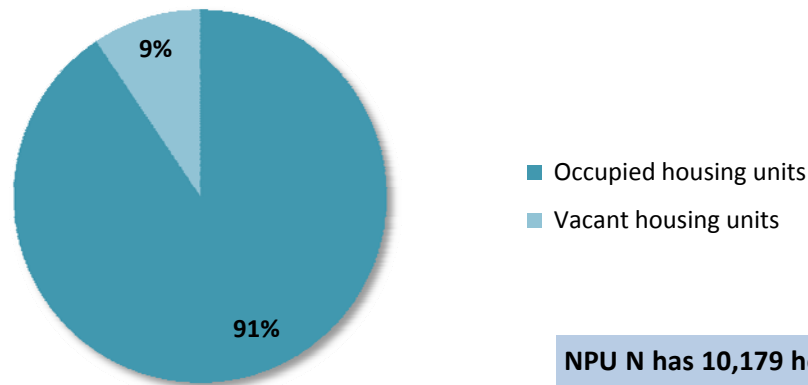


99% of the NPU N population lives in households and 1% (100) lives in Group Quarters.



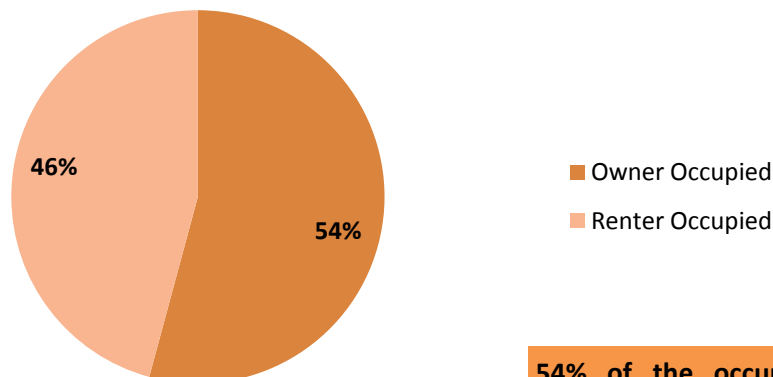
HOUSING

2010 Housing Occupancy - NPU N



NPU N has 10,179 housing units, an increase of 1721 units (20%) from 8,458 in 2000. 91% of all housing units are occupied and 9% are vacant. Rental units have 8% vacancy rate while owner occupied units have a 6% vacancy rate.

2010 Housing Tenure - NPU N



54% of the occupied housing units are owner occupied and 46% are renter occupied. In 2000, 56% of housing units were owner occupied while 44% were owner occupied.

Renter occupied units have 1.62 persons per households and owner occupied units have 2.09 persons per households.
