




CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU J: 2010 POPULATION


According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) J is 11,889 a decrease of 5,196 (30%) from a 2000 population of 17,085. The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU J. NPU J had an overall density of 4.4 persons per acre.



AGE




The population of NPU J has a median age of 37. 25% of the population is under 18, 16% of the population is over 65 and 23% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.




In 2000, NPU J had a median age of 34.3. 16% of the population was over 65, and 26% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.

RACE






96% of the NPU J population is Black, 2% is White, 0% is Asian, 2% is other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other). 1% of the population is of Hispanic or Latin Origin.



In 2000, the racial composition of NPU G was 98% Black, 1% White, 0% Asian and 1% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other). 1% of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.



HOUSEHOLDS




There are 11,376 NPU J residents in 4,269 households. Of these, 59% are family households and 41% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 31% have children under age 18 and 34% have an individual 65 years and older.

33% of households are single person households, with 11% being single person households over 65, 34% are female headed households and 17% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.66 persons per household and the average family size is 3.43 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 5,904 households in NPU J, 36% had children under age 18 and 29% were single person households. The average household size was 2.7 persons per household.


2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU J




96% of the NPU J population lives in households and 4% (513) lives in Group Quarters.



HOUSING





44% of the occupied housing units are owner occupied and 56% are renter occupied. In 2000, 45% of housing units were owner occupied while 55% were renter occupied.

Renter occupied units have 2.85 persons per households and owner occupied units have 2.43 persons per households.
