## Seaboard Avenue Resurfacing and Restriping

July 2021



### Project Description

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) has identified an opportunity for quick implementation of safety improvements on Seaboard Avenue NE. ATLDOT will be resurfacing Seaboard Avenue NE in 2021 as a part of the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) program. In an effort to improve safety for all roadway users, the city will be restriping the street upon completion of the resurfacing, to accommodate on-street parking as well as dedicated and shared bike facilities. This is an excellent opportunity to improve the road conditions in a way that improves safety and multimodal connectivity.

### Location

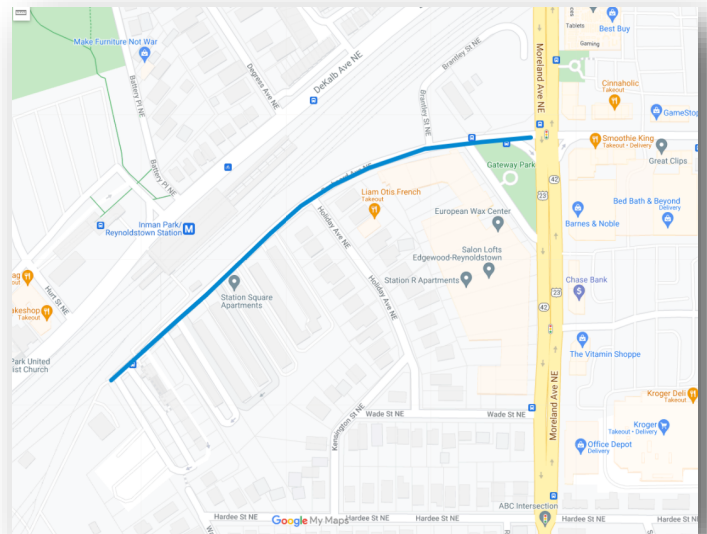
Seaboard Avenue NE, between Moreland Avenue NE and Walthal Street NE.

### Schedule

Project construction is anticipated to begin between August and December 2021, weather permitting.

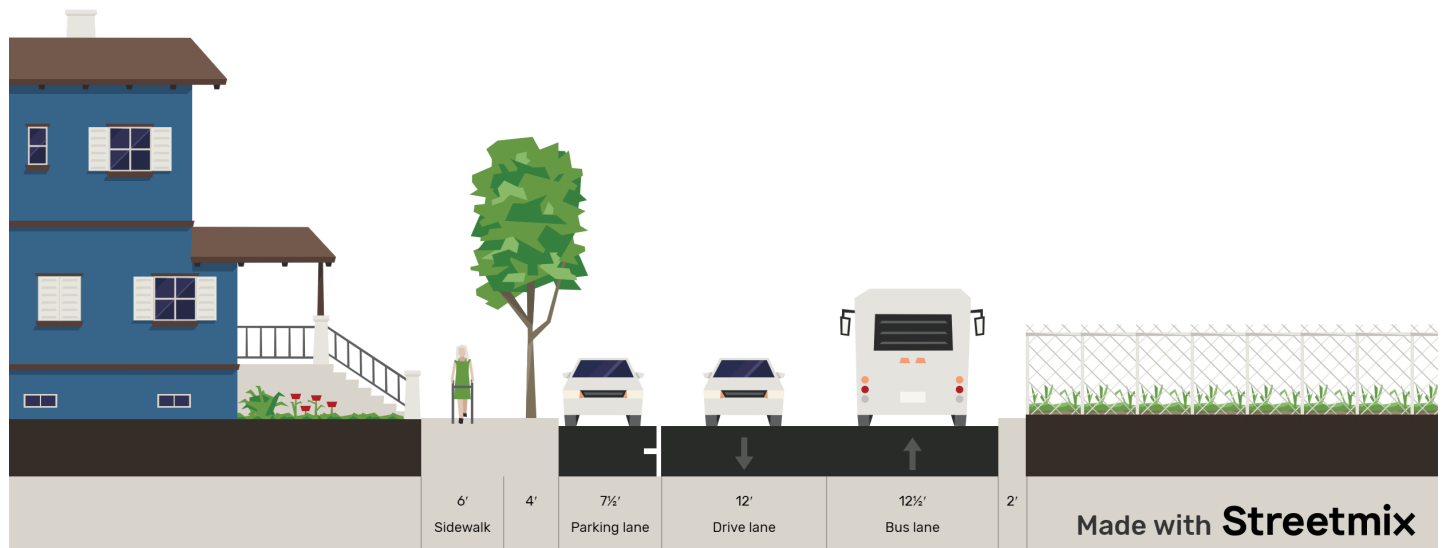

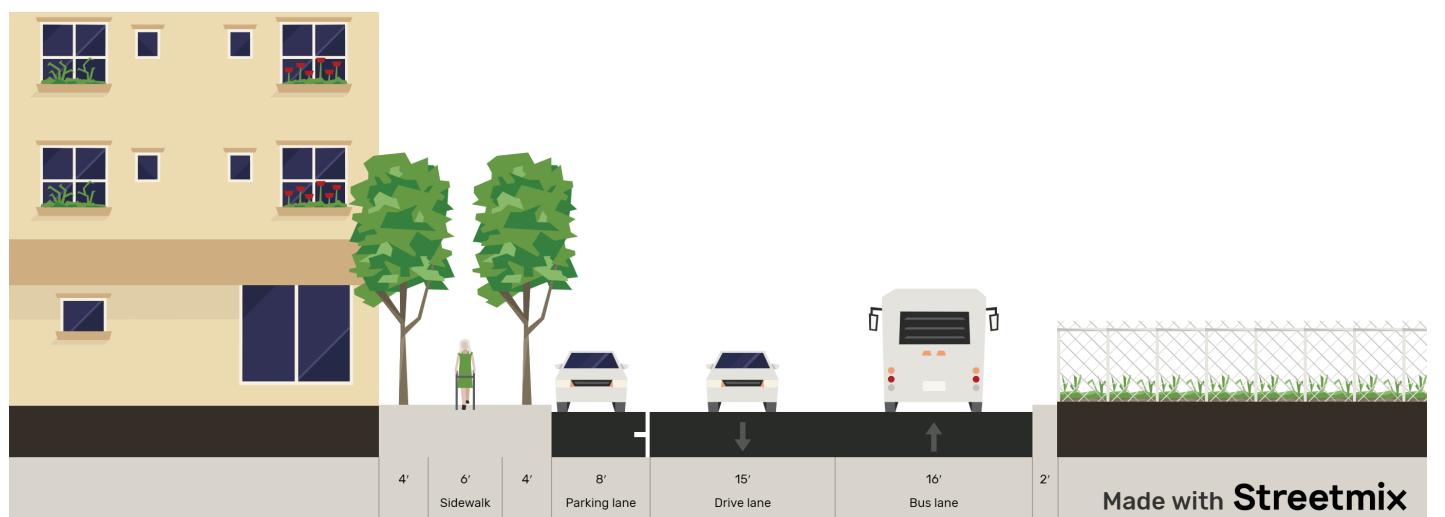
## Seaboard Avenue Resurfacing and Restriping Existing Conditions

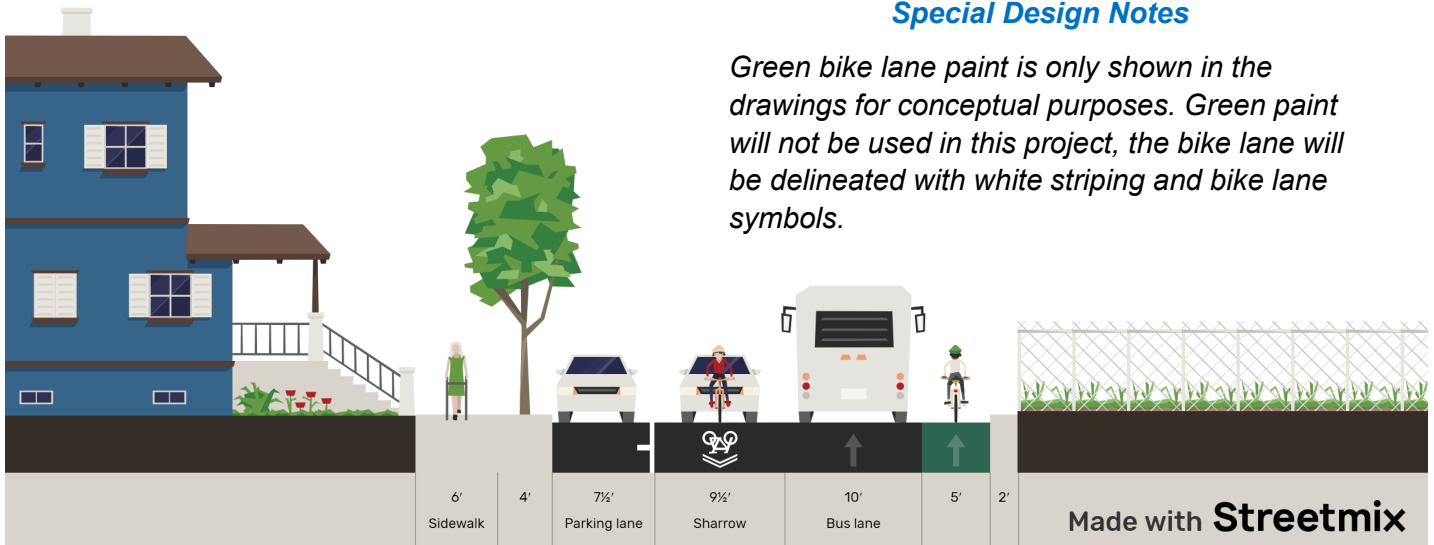
## Stratford Road Resurfacing and Restriping
