## Krog Tunnel Stormwater Project


### Project to Address Flooding in the Tunnel

#### Phase 1:

- Install inlets and new storm pipe near Dekalb Avenue and Krog Street intersection
- Restoration of damaged infrastructure
- January 2022 – April 2022

#### Phase 2:

- Install new larger storm pipe through the tunnel to Wylie Street.
- Late 2022





## Krog Tunnel Stormwater Project

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### **Potential Impacts – Preliminary Road Closure Plan**

- Dekalb Avenue Lane Closure of South Lane (closest to the rail)
  - January 2022 to April 2022
  - Two lanes of traffic in both directions expected to be maintained
    - Middle lane - east bound
    - North lane - west bound
- Krog Tunnel Closure to Vehicles and Pedestrians
  - Approximately 3 weeks in January 2022
  - Preliminary Detour – Boulevard to Memorial Drive
- Krog Street Closure to Vehicles and Pedestrians
  - Edgewood to Dekalb Ave
  - Approximately 4 weeks in February 2022
  - Preliminary Detour – Edgewood Avenue
