Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard Resurfacing and Restriping Coming Soon

In 2020, Atlanta City Council adopted the city's first roadway safety program, Vision Zero Atlanta, which aims to eliminate serious injuries and fatalities caused by traffic crashes in the city.

The City of Atlanta identifies every opportunity to make improvements to city streets. As a part of its annual resurfacing program, the City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) will be resurfacing Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard, between Sells Avenue and Washington Place in Fall 2021 and has identified this location as an opportunity for quick implementation of dedicated bike facilities along certain portions of the corridor, through a Georgia Department of Transportation Local Infrastructure Maintenance Grant (LMIG).

This project is a part of a group of streets being resurfaced between August and December 2021, weather permitting. The Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard project has been developed and designed by city staff. This project provides a tremendous opportunity to improve neighborhood safety.

ATLDOT will be offering an opportunity for the community to provide comments on this project, however, it should be considered that this project will advance rapidly.
