## Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard Resurfacing and Restriping



### Project Description

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) has identified an opportunity for quick implementation of safety improvements on Joseph E. Lowery Boulevard, between White St and Ralph David Abernathy (RDA) Blvd. ATLDOT will be resurfacing this street in the Fall 2021 as a part of the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) program. In an effort to improve safety for all roadway users, the city will be restriping the street upon completion of the resurfacing, to accommodate on-street, dedicated bike facilities from White St to RDA. The resurfacing will also extend from RDA to Washington Pl. This is an excellent opportunity to improve the road conditions in a way that improves safety and multimodal

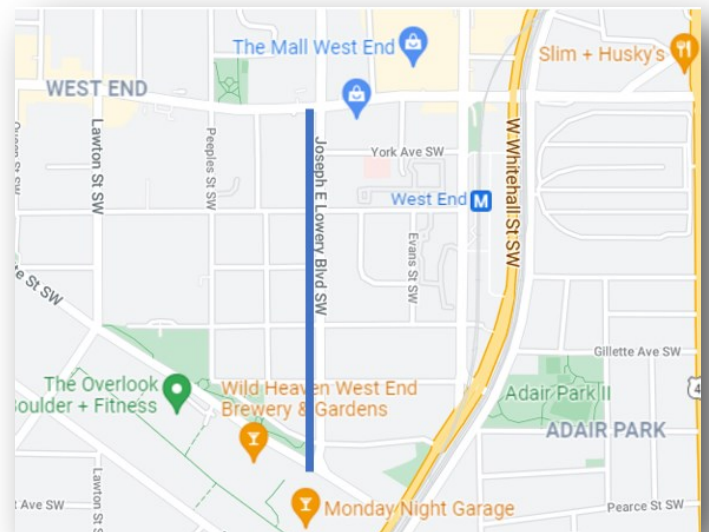
### Location

Project construction is anticipated to begin between November and December 2021, weather permitting.

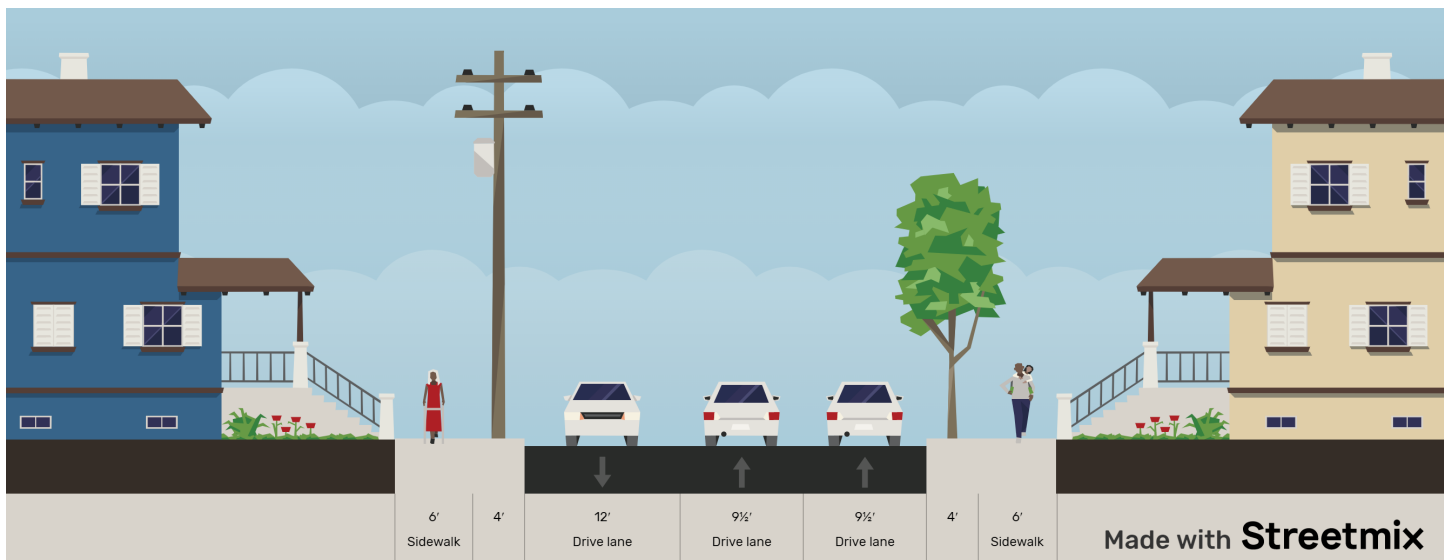
