## Lionel Lane Resurfacing and Restriping

April 2022

### Project Description

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) is designing safety improvements for Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Drive. Projected to begin in Summer/Fall 2022, planned improvements include resurfacing and restriping to accommodate an on-street, dedicated walk lane to connect to the sidewalk on Montgomery Ferry Drive. This project would upgrade road surface condition and improve multimodal safety and connectivity.

### Location

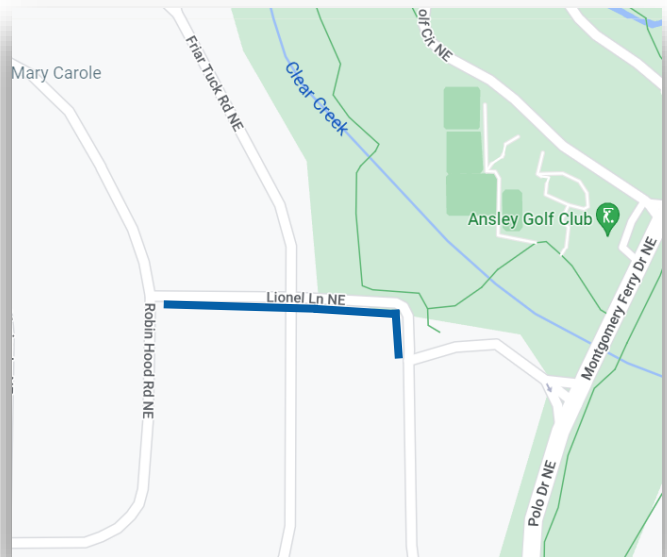
Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Drive

Project construction is anticipated to begin between August and September 2022, weather permitting.

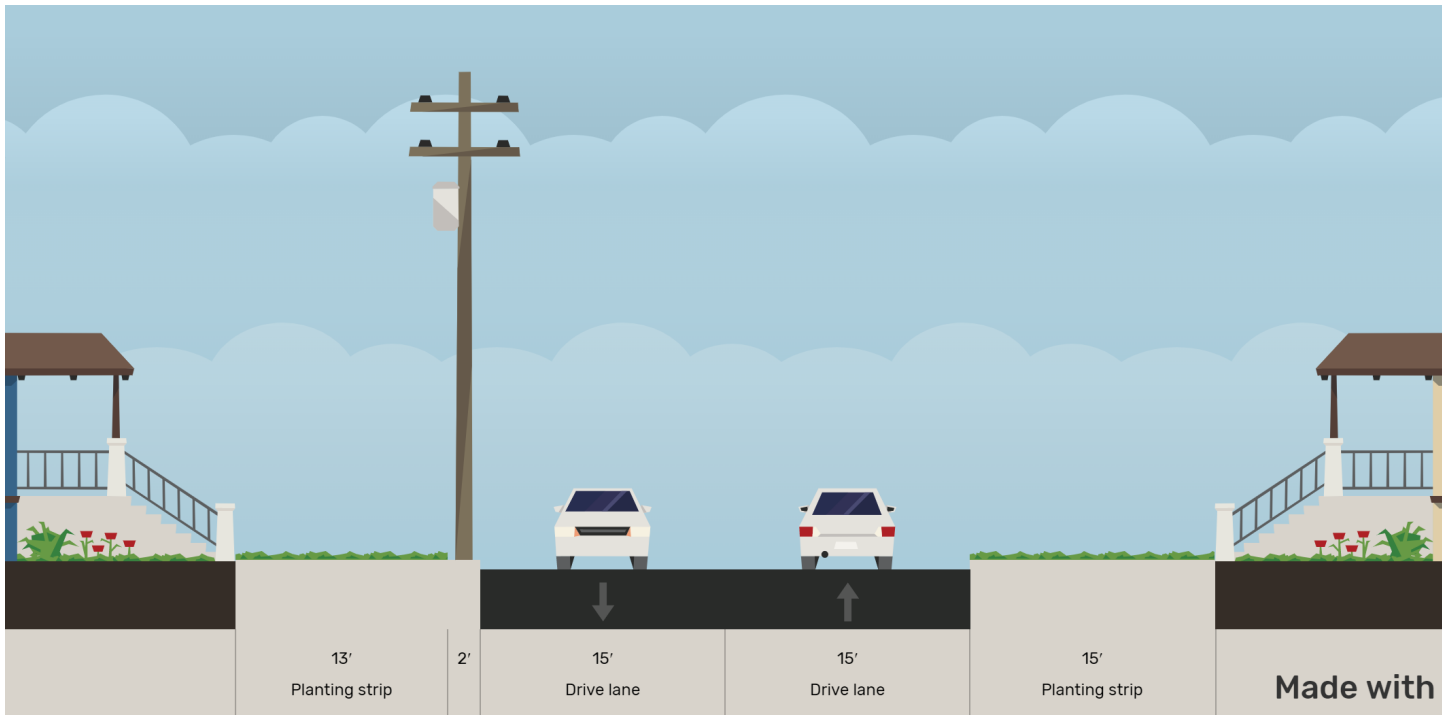
