Lionel Lane Resurfacing and Restriping Coming Soon

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) planners have reviewed and developed design options for Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Road. Lionel Lane is scheduled for resurfacing and restriping between May and October 2022, weather permitting.

Planned improvements for Lionel Lane (*see attached project fact sheet*) include resurfacing and restriping to accommodate an on-street, dedicated walk lanes to promote safe access for all roadway users. This project would improve the road surface condition, increase multimodal connectivity, and enhance safety for pedestrians.
