Lionel Lane Resurfacing and Restriping Coming Soon

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) has reviewed and developed design options for Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Road. Lionel Lane is scheduled for resurfacing and restriping between July and October 2022, weather permitting.

Planned improvements for Lionel Lane (see attached project fact sheet) include resurfacing and restriping to accommodate an on-street, dedicated walk lane to promote safe access for all roadway users. This project will improve the road surface condition, increase multimodal connectivity, and enhance safety for pedestrians.

ATLDOT solicited community input and comments on the Lionel Lane Restriping plan during a 30-day public comment period, which ended June 27, 2022. Further project details are available on the ATLDOT website project page at: <u>https://atldot.atlantaga.gov/projects/2020-Imig-resurfacing</u>.

Based upon feedback from the community, ATLDOT has made revisions to the original concept design, to include:

- Resurfacing along the entire Lionel Lane, from Montgomery Ferry Drive west to Robin Hood Road.
- The planned walk lane will now extend along the southern curb of Lionel Lane, from Friar Tuck Road to the 90-degree turn of Lionel Lane.
- Signing and marking to improve the visibility and safety of the 90-degree turn and at the intersection with Montgomery Ferry Drive. These improvements include "No Parking" signage along the southern curb.
- New curb ramps where the walk lane connects to the existing sidewalk at the 90 degree turn, as well as at the intersection of Montgomery Ferry Drive, to provide accessibility for a new crosswalk location with better visibility to both directions of travel along Montgomery Ferry Drive.
