PROJECT UPDATE



DeKalb Avenue/Krog Street Safety and Drainage Improvements

Project Descriptions

The City of Atlanta's departments of Transportation and Watershed Management are working to deliver safety and drainage improvements in the DeKalb Avenue corridor and Krog Street Tunnel. Crews will begin drainage improvement work in the Krog Street Tunnel within the next 60 days. Traffic signal upgrades at several DeKalb Avenue intersections are under way and lighting installations in the tunnel are nearly complete.

Locations

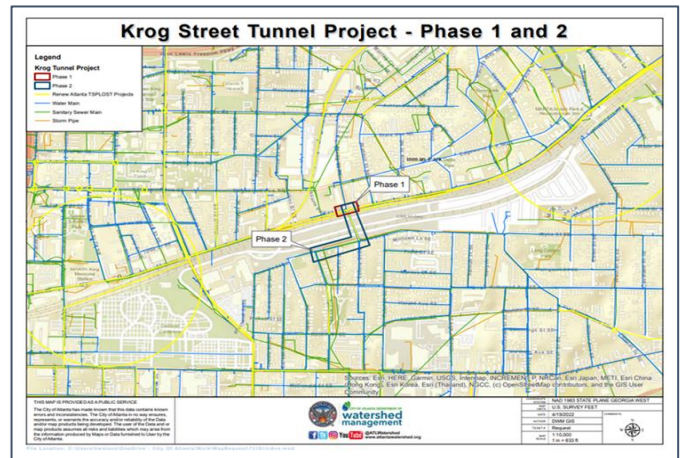
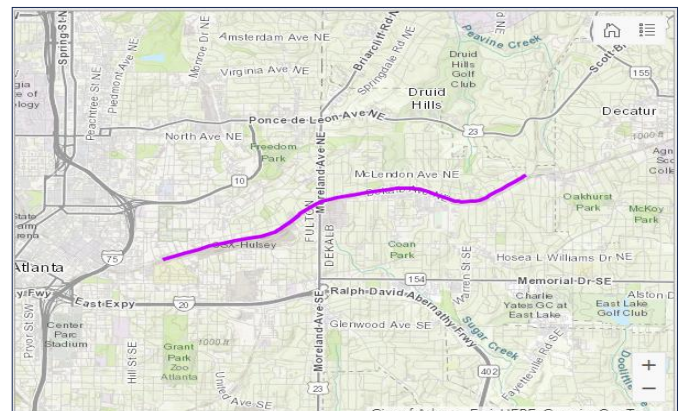
- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue from Jackson Street to Ridgecrest Road
- ⇒ DeKalb Avenue/Krog Street intersection
- ⇒ Krog Street Tunnel, between DeKalb Avenue NE and Wylie Street SE

Schedules

- ⇒ Target completion for the DeKalb Avenue Safety Improvements project is Fall 2023.
- ⇒ The Krog Street Tunnel Lighting is projected for completion in Fall 2022.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase I is slated to begin in September, with projected completion in Fall 2022.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase II will begin upon completion of Phase I, with target completion date of Spring 2023.

Other Details

- ⇒ Traffic signal work began in late July at several intersections between Jackson Street SE and Rockyford Road NE. Crews are installing upgraded technology for timing coordination and left-turn signals for safer intersection crossings once activated.
- ⇒ At the Krog Street Tunnel, lighting installation on the east side of the tunnel is complete; west side installation will be complete by the end of August.
- ⇒ In September, Department of Watershed Management (DWM) crews will begin work on the Krog Street Stormwater Drainage-Phase I project to restore the drainage system and mitigate flooding in the Krog Street Tunnel.
- ⇒ Installation of new inlets and approximately 400 linear feet of stormwater pipeline will take place at night and require temporary closure of the southbound lane. Target completion for Phase I is Fall 2022.
