Lionel Lane Resurfacing and Restriping

August 2022

Project Description

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) is designing safety improvements for Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Drive. Projected to begin in Summer/Fall 2022, planned improvements include resurfacing and restriping to accommodate some on-street parking. Sidewalk and curb ramp improvements are included near Montgomery Ferry Drive. This project will upgrade road surface condition and improve pedestrian and driver safety.

Location

Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Drive


Schedule

Project construction is anticipated to begin between August and September 2022, weather permitting.

Next Steps

- ⇒ A previous 30-day public comment period closed on June 27, 2022.
- ⇒ Based upon feedback from the community, ATLDOT made revisions to the design to focus on driver safety and accommodating some on-street parking.




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Existing Typical Conditions
