Lionel Lane Resurfacing and Restriping Coming Soon

The City of Atlanta Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) has reviewed and developed design options for Lionel Lane, between Robin Hood Road and Montgomery Ferry Road. Lionel Lane is scheduled for resurfacing and restriping between August and October 2022, weather permitting.

Planned improvements for Lionel Lane (see project fact sheet) include resurfacing and restriping to accommodate some on-street parking. Sidewalk and curb ramp improvements are included near Montgomery Ferry Drive. This project will upgrade road surface condition and improve pedestrian and driver safety.

ATLDOT solicited community input and comments on the Lionel Lane Restriping plan during a 30-day public comment period, which ended June 27, 2022. Further project details are available on the ATLDOT website project page at: <u>https://atldot.atlantaga.gov/projects/2020-lmig-resurfacing</u>.

Based upon a second round of feedback from the community, ATLDOT has made revisions to the preliminary design, to include in the final design:

- Resurfacing along the entire Lionel Lane, from Montgomery Ferry Drive west to Robin Hood Road.
- The planned walk lane was eliminated to accommodate some on-street parking from Friar Tuck Road to approximately 100' west of the 90 degree turn of Lionel Lane.
- Signing and marking to improve the visibility and safety of the 90-degree turn and at the intersection with Montgomery Ferry Drive is still included. These improvements include "No Parking" signage along the southern curb.
- Curb ramps where the parking lane connects to the existing sidewalk at the 90 degree turn, as well as at the intersection of Montgomery Ferry Drive, to provide accessibility for a new crosswalk location with better visibility to both directions of travel along Montgomery Ferry Drive.
