PROJECT UPDATE



Cascade Avenue/Road Complete Street Phase I

Project Descriptions

The City of Atlanta's Departments of Transportation and Watershed Management are working to deliver corridor improvements along approximately two (2) miles of Cascade Road/Avenue. Planned improvements include milling, resurfacing, restriping, sidewalks, traffic communications corridor signal upgrades, bus stop enhancements, streetscapes, extended bike lanes, pedestrian safety improvements, and relocation of hydrants, water main lines, sidewalk meter boxes, and street valve box adjustments.

Locations

Cascade Road/Avenue SW from the City Limits to Willis Mill Road SW and Delowe Drive SW to Avon Avenue SW

Schedules

- ⇒ Target completion for the Cascade Road/Avenue Complete Street Phase I roadway improvements is Spring 2025.
- ⇒ DWM waterline relocation is scheduled to begin in the 4th quarter of 2022, with projected completion in the 3rd quarter of 2023.



Other Details

- ⇒ ATLDOT crews continue clearing, erosion control, and utility relocation activities throughout the project limits.
- ⇒ DWM will relocate approximately 500 linear feet of water main lines.
- ⇒ DWM's water line relocation work is scheduled to begin in late September/early October.
- ⇒ Impacted property owners will be notified (i.e., door knock, letter, door hanger) prior to the start of the scheduled relocation work.
- ⇒ There are no anticipated road closures associated with the water line relocation work; however, intermittent lane closures may be required to accommodate the work. Traffic advisories will be posted to the DWM and ATLDOT websites and social media platforms.
