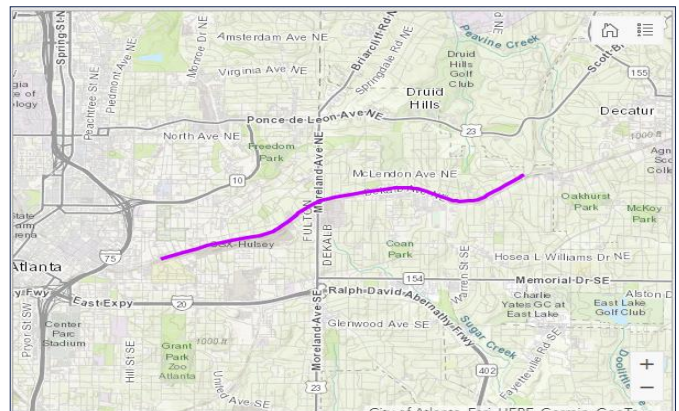
Dekalb Avenue/Krog Street Safety and Drainage Improvements

Project Descriptions

The City of Atlanta's departments of Transportation and Watershed Management are working to deliver safety and drainage improvements in the Dekalb Avenue corridor and Krog Street Tunnel. Crews will begin drainage improvement work in the Krog Street Tunnel the week of September 19, 2022. In addition, resurfacing of Dekalb Avenue NE is scheduled to begin in late September/early October 2022.

Locations

- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE (Decatur Street SE) from Jackson Street SE to Ridgcrest Road NE (Atlanta City Limit)
- ⇒ Krog Street NE/Dekalb Avenue NE intersection
- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE from Waddell Street NE to Cornelia Street SE
- ⇒ Krog Street from Dekalb Avenue and Edgewood Avenue NE

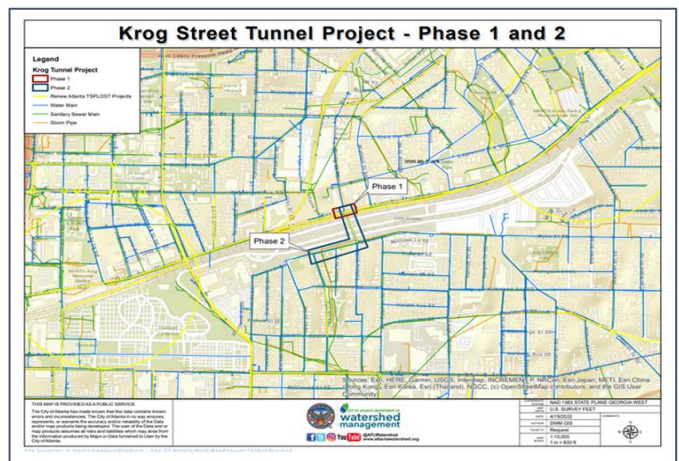


Schedules

- ⇒ Target completion for the DeKalb Avenue Safety Improvements project is Fall 2023.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase I is slated to begin the week of September 19th, with projected completion in Fall 2022.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase II will begin upon completion of Phase I, with target completion date of Spring 2023.

Other Details

- ⇒ During the week of September 19th, Department of Watershed Management (DWM) crews will begin work on the Krog Street Stormwater Drainage-Phase I project to restore the drainage system and mitigate flooding in the Krog Street Tunnel.
- ⇒ Installation of new inlets and approximately 400 linear feet of stormwater pipeline will take place Sunday-Friday at night from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- ⇒ Krog Street Tunnel from Dekalb Avenue NE to Wylie Street SE will be closed beginning Tuesday, September 20, 2022, through December 2022 to accommodate the construction at the Krog Street NE/Dekalb Avenue NE intersection.
- ⇒ Resurfacing of Dekalb Avenue NE from Ridgcrest Road SE (Atlanta City Limits) to Jackson Street SE is scheduled to begin late September/early October 2022.
- ⇒ Resurfacing is scheduled to begin at the Atlanta City Limits and move westward to the end of the project limits at Jackson Street SE, bypassing the Krog Street/Dekalb Avenue stormwater improvements construction area.
