

# PROJECT UPDATE



## Cheshire Bridge Rebuild

October 31, 2022

### Project Description

The Atlanta Department of Transportation is pleased to announce the partial reopening of Cheshire Bridge over South Fork Peachtree Creek. On Monday, October 31, 2022, crews opened one lane in both directions to traffic. C. W. Matthews construction crews performed work both daily and nightly, to help accomplish the reopening as scheduled. The remaining lanes will be reopened in Spring 2023 following the completion of ongoing utility relocation work.


### Location

Cheshire Bridge Road NE from Woodland Avenue NE to Faulkner Road NE

### Schedule

The projected completion of utility work and the reopening of all lanes is Spring 2023.

### Other Details



- ⇒ Two lanes—one northbound and one southbound lane—are currently open.
- ⇒ The westside pedestrian sidewalk has reopened.
- ⇒ Utility relocation work will continue throughout the remainder of this project. This work may include temporary lane shifts at times.
- ⇒ No full road closures are anticipated during this final phase of construction.
- ⇒ All lanes and utility relocations are expected to be completed in Spring 2023
