




Typical Existing Conditions - MLK Jr. Dr.





<u>Typical Proposed Interim Conditions - MLK Jr. Dr.</u> (Fall 2022 through Spring 2023)




Typical Proposed Conditions - MLK Jr. Dr. (Final striping from Resurfacing Project until BRT Project is installed)





Typical Existing Conditions - Mitchell St. (before Resurfacing)






