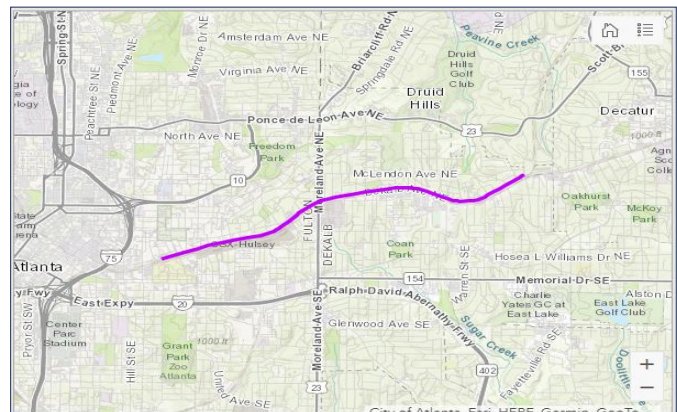
Dekalb Avenue/Krog Street Safety and Drainage Improvements

Project Descriptions

The City of Atlanta's Departments of Transportation (ATLDOT) and Watershed Management (DWM) are working to deliver safety and drainage improvements in the Dekalb Avenue corridor and Krog Street Tunnel. Crews are continuing the drainage improvement work in the Krog Street Tunnel. The DWM contractor has advised of an unforeseen construction challenge that will impact the target completion date for drainage improvements. The City is working with the contractor on a revised schedule.

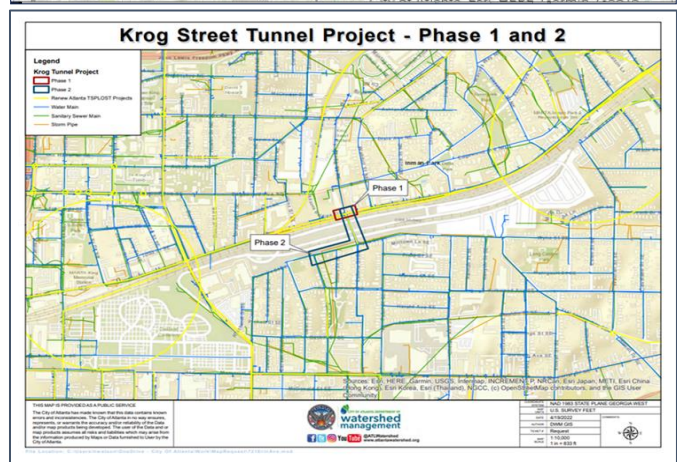
Locations

- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE (Decatur Street SE) from Jackson Street SE to Ridgcrest Road NE (Atlanta City Limit)
- ⇒ Krog Street NE/Dekalb Avenue NE intersection
- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE from Waddell Street NE to Cornelia Street SE
- ⇒ Krog Street from Dekalb Avenue and Edgewood Avenue NE



Schedules

- ⇒ Target completion for the Dekalb Avenue Safety Improvements project is Fall 2023.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase I is underway, with a projected completion during the first quarter of 2023
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase II will begin upon completion of Phase I.



What's New?

- ⇒ Drainage improvement work along the Krog Street NE/DeKalb Avenue NE intersection continues, with approximately 20 percent of stormwater pipe installation completed. However, unforeseen structural challenges discovered beneath the roadway have delayed progress, pushing the target completion of the project to the first quarter of 2023.
- ⇒ Utility relocation work within the project limits is scheduled to begin Spring 2023. Resurfacing of Dekalb Avenue NE (Decatur Street SE) from Jackson Street SE to Ridgcrest Road SE (Atlanta City Limits) will follow necessary infrastructure improvements, pending personnel availability and optimal weather conditions.

Other Details (Continued)

- ⇒ Krog Street Tunnel from Dekalb Avenue NE to Wylie Street SE will be closed nightly from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday-Friday, to accommodate the construction at the Krog Street NE/Dekalb Avenue NE intersection.
- ⇒ One sidewalk within the Krog Street Tunnel, will remain open during the project. However, some construction activity (i.e., work that requires heavy equipment to install storm pipes, etc.) will require restricted sidewalk access on both sides.
