# Dekalb Avenue/Krog Street Safety and Drainage Improvements

#### **Project Descriptions**

The City of Atlanta's Departments of Transportation (ATLDOT) and Watershed Management (DWM) are working to deliver safety and drainage improvements in the Dekalb Avenue corridor and Krog Street Tunnel. Crews are continuing the drainage improvement work in the Krog Street Tunnel. Work on Phase I of the drainage project is complete, and work on Dekalb Avenue has resumed.

#### Locations

- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE (Decatur Street SE) from Jackson Street SE to Ridgecrest Road NE (Atlanta City Limit)
- $\Rightarrow$  Krog Street NE/Dekalb Avenue NE intersection
- $\Rightarrow$  Dekalb Avenue NE from Waddell Street NE to Cornelia Street SE
- $\Rightarrow$  Krog Street from Dekalb Avenue and Edgewood Avenue NE

#### Schedules

- $\Rightarrow$  Target completion for the Dekalb Avenue Safety Improvements project is Fall 2023.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage Phase I is complete.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage Phase II will begin when CSX permit is issued allowing work underneath the Krog Street tunnel.

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### What's New?

- ⇒ Nearly 70 potholes on Dekalb Avenue between Krog Street and Moreland Avenue have been filled to improve existing roadway safety and quality.
- ⇒ Phase I of drainage improvement work along the Krog Street NE/DeKalb Avenue NE intersection stormwater pipe installation is complete.
- ⇒ With the initial phase of drainage improvements complete, Dekalb Avenue Safety Improvements work has resumed. Crews are on-site lowering manhole and valve covers in preparation for resurfacing.
- ⇒ Reversible lane signals have been switched to default mode in preparation for their removal. Signals will no longer switch directions to accommodate rush hour traffic volumes.
- ⇒ Weather permitting, temporary striping will be installed and reversible lane equipment (signals and overhead poles) will be removed in May 2023.
- ⇒ Also, resurfacing (milling, patching, and paving) of Dekalb Avenue NE (Decatur Street SE) from Jackson Street SE to Ridgecrest Road SE (Atlanta City Limits) is scheduled to begin in May 2023, pending weather conditions.
