# PROJECT UPDATE



## Dekalb Avenue/Krog Street Safety and Drainage Improvements

### Project Descriptions

The City of Atlanta's Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) and Watershed Management (DWM) are working to deliver drainage and safety improvements in the Dekalb Avenue corridor and Krog Street Tunnel. Manhole adjustments on Dekalb Avenue have been completed, and ATLDOT is pleased to announce that resurfacing of the roadway is scheduled to begin on Monday, May 15.

### Locations

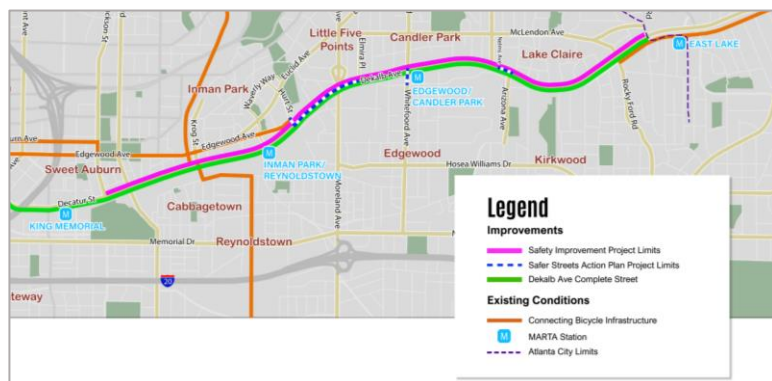
- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE (Decatur Street SE) from Ridgecrest Road NE (Atlanta City Limit) to Jackson Street SE
- ⇒ Krog Street NE/Dekalb Avenue NE intersection
- ⇒ Dekalb Avenue NE from Waddell Street NE to Cornelia Street SE
- ⇒ Krog Street from Dekalb Avenue and Edgewood Avenue NE

### Schedules

- ⇒ Target completion for Dekalb Avenue NE resurfacing is Summer 2023.
- ⇒ Target completion for the entire Dekalb Avenue Safety Improvements project is the end of 2023.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase I is complete.
- ⇒ Krog Street Stormwater Drainage - Phase II will begin when CSX permit is issued allowing work underneath the Krog Street tunnel.

### What's New?

- ⇒ **Resurfacing activities, including milling, patching, and paving, are slated to begin on Monday, May 15, 2023.** Work will be performed nightly from 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Sunday evenings through Friday mornings to minimize impact to road users. Some additional weekend work is anticipated. Notice of associated schedule and/or traffic pattern changes will be provided prior to implementation.
- ⇒ The Dekalb Avenue Safety Improvement Project includes traffic signal coordination upgrades, intersection improvements, resurfacing, and bicycle lane installations on Dekalb Avenue.
- ⇒ Traffic flow will be maintained for the duration of the resurfacing, though intermittent lane closures may cause traffic delays. There may be noise or light disturbances associated with the overnight work.
- ⇒ As with all resurfacing projects, the schedule may be affected by adverse weather.
