Bolton Road Improvements Project

Project Description

The City of Atlanta's Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) is pleased to announce the impending start of permanent resurfacing on a portion of the Bolton Road corridor. The project will include milling, paving, restriping, sidewalk repair/installation, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant ramp installation, drainage improvements, and utility adjustments. Work is scheduled to begin the week of September 18, 2023.

Location

Bolton Road NW from Parrott Avenue NW to Barnett Drive SW

Schedule

- Mid-September 2023 to Mid-November 2023
 - Resurfacing
 - Sidewalk, curbing, ADA-compliant ramp upgrades
 - Signage and striping installation
 - Manhole and water valve adjustments



Late September 2023 to March 2024

Study and design for drainage and safety improvements at three (3) locations - CSX Bridge, Marietta Road, and Parrott Avenue

December 2023

Target completion for majority of project scope, except three (3) study areas

March 2024

Target completion for drainage improvements

Details

- The Bolton Road Improvements Project includes:
 - Approximately 1.35 miles of milling and paving from Parrott Avenue NW to Barnett Drive NW
 - Pavement markings, signage, and striping
 - o ADA-compliant ramp upgrades
 - Sidewalk repairs/installation, driveway aprons, and drainage improvements
- Resurfacing activities, including milling, patching, and paving, are slated to begin the week of September 18, 2023, and will be performed nightly from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sunday evenings through Friday mornings to minimize impact to road users. Work to install/upgrade sidewalk and ADA-compliant ramps and drainage improvements will take place weekdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Notice of associated schedule and/or traffic pattern changes will be provided prior to implementation.
- Intermittent lane closures will be in effect from the start of construction until work concludes. Law enforcement officers will be onsite to assist with traffic control. Traffic flow will be maintained for the duration of the resurfacing, though intermittent lane closures may cause traffic delays. Traffic will be restored to normal operations when work is not in progress.
- There may be noise or light disturbances associated with the overnight work. Access to some driveways and sidewalks may restricted for 24 to 48 hours to allow for repairs/replacement.
