Howell Mill Complete Street Project

Project Description

The City of Atlanta's Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) continues work on the Howell Complete Street project under construction since December 2023.

The project includes sidewalk repairs and ADA ramp upgrades, new midblock crossings, new signalized intersections and existing intersection signal upgrades, fiber optic installation and traffic signal timing coordination, new dedicated left-turn lanes, as well as raised and roadway bicycle lane installations.

Location

Marietta Street NW to Collier Road NW

Schedule

In progress:

- Sidewalk, concrete gutter, curb, and driveway apron repair/replacement
- ADA ramp replacement
- Median island installations

Next steps:

- Sidewalk, concrete gutter, curb, and driveway apron repair/replacement
- Utility relocations (power, gas, telecommunications, cable)
- Intersection signal upgrades
- New intersection signal installations
- Drainage improvements

(PLEASE NOTE: Unforeseen construction challenges could impact the project milestone dates listed above.)

Details

- Construction will continue Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. (possible extended hours with additional seasonal daylight).
- Intermittent lane closures may be in place to accommodate resurfacing and other activities within the roadway. Traffic flow will be maintained for the duration of resurfacing, though intermittent lane closures may cause traffic delays.
- As with all construction projects, the schedule and work activities may be affected by adverse weather.
