

Atlanta Streets Alive (ASA) opens streets temporarily for constituents to bike, walk, skate, dance, and play. It is FREE to the public; the event turns the street into a park space that connects our city.

ASA is a community engagement platform that encourages positive experiences through public safety with city services such as ATLDOT, APD, DPW.







## Goals

Atlanta Streets Alive aims to promote community engagement, active living, and healthy lifestyles by temporarily closing streets to vehicular traffic and opening them for people to walk, bike, skate, and participate in various activities.



Atlanta Streets Alive was formally run by the Atlanta Bike Coalition, now Propel ATL, for 10 years, producing 29 open streets programs with estimated 1.5 million total attendees.



In 2020, legislation was drafted to establish ASA as a recurring program by the City of Atlanta.

In 2023, ATLDOT hired staff to make this a reality.


















## How many people attended?


## How many people attended?

12,953 people between 12noon - 6pm









## Where did they come from? A: All over!

41% of attendees walked or ran33% biked or scooted12% MARTA13% took a personal vehicle






28% increase in MARTA ridership at 7 stations





No cars on Peachtree St. 11am – 6pm




Wear comfortable shoes, bring sunscreen, weather protection, and a water bottle.

Shift two: 2:15pm - 5:30pm


**Event Time: 1pm – 5pm**

Find your safety banner at the intersection.













Open the banner when the traffic light is RED.


