**Sunday, May 18, 2014**

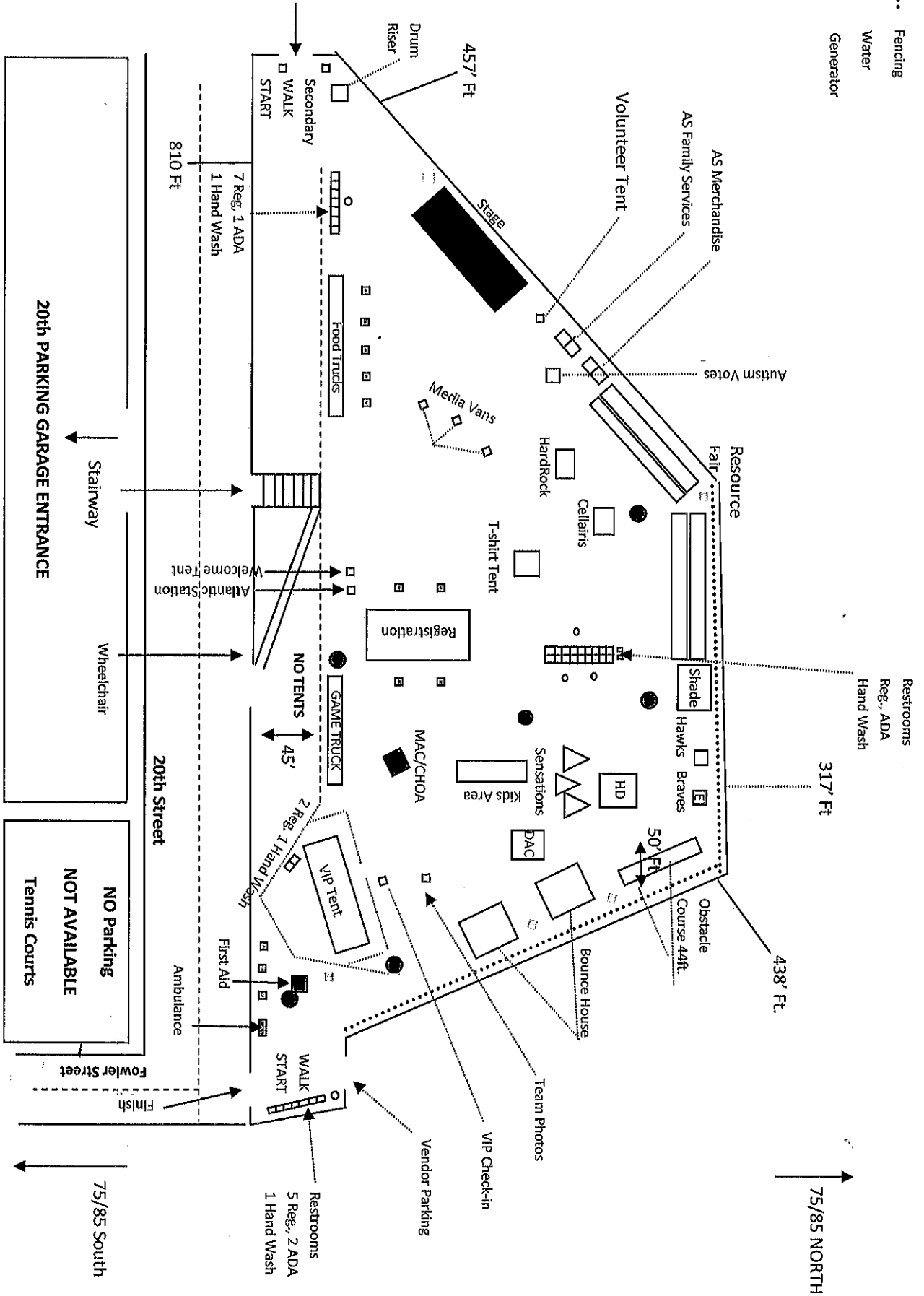
## *Route Descriptions*

### **9:30 am – 1.5 Mile Route**

- The Walk will start on the Pinnacle Site, at the gate opposite to the intersection of 20<sup>th</sup> street and State Street.
- The route will exit the Pinnacle Site at the corner of 20<sup>th</sup> Street and walk towards State Street. (Secondary start point 20<sup>th</sup> Street and State)
- The route will proceed southwest (straight ahead) on State Street to 18<sup>th</sup> Street.
- The route will turn right on 18<sup>th</sup> Street, and proceed west to Village Street.
- The route will turn left on 17<sup>th</sup> Street, and proceed east to Market Street.
- The route will turn right on Market Street, and proceed south to 16<sup>th</sup> Street.
- The route will turn left on 16<sup>th</sup> Street, and proceed east to Fowler Street.
- The route will turn left on Fowler Street, and proceed north to 20<sup>th</sup> Street.
- The route will cross 20<sup>th</sup> Street and return through the gate into the Pinnacle Site.
- The route will finish on the Pinnacle Site near the stage.

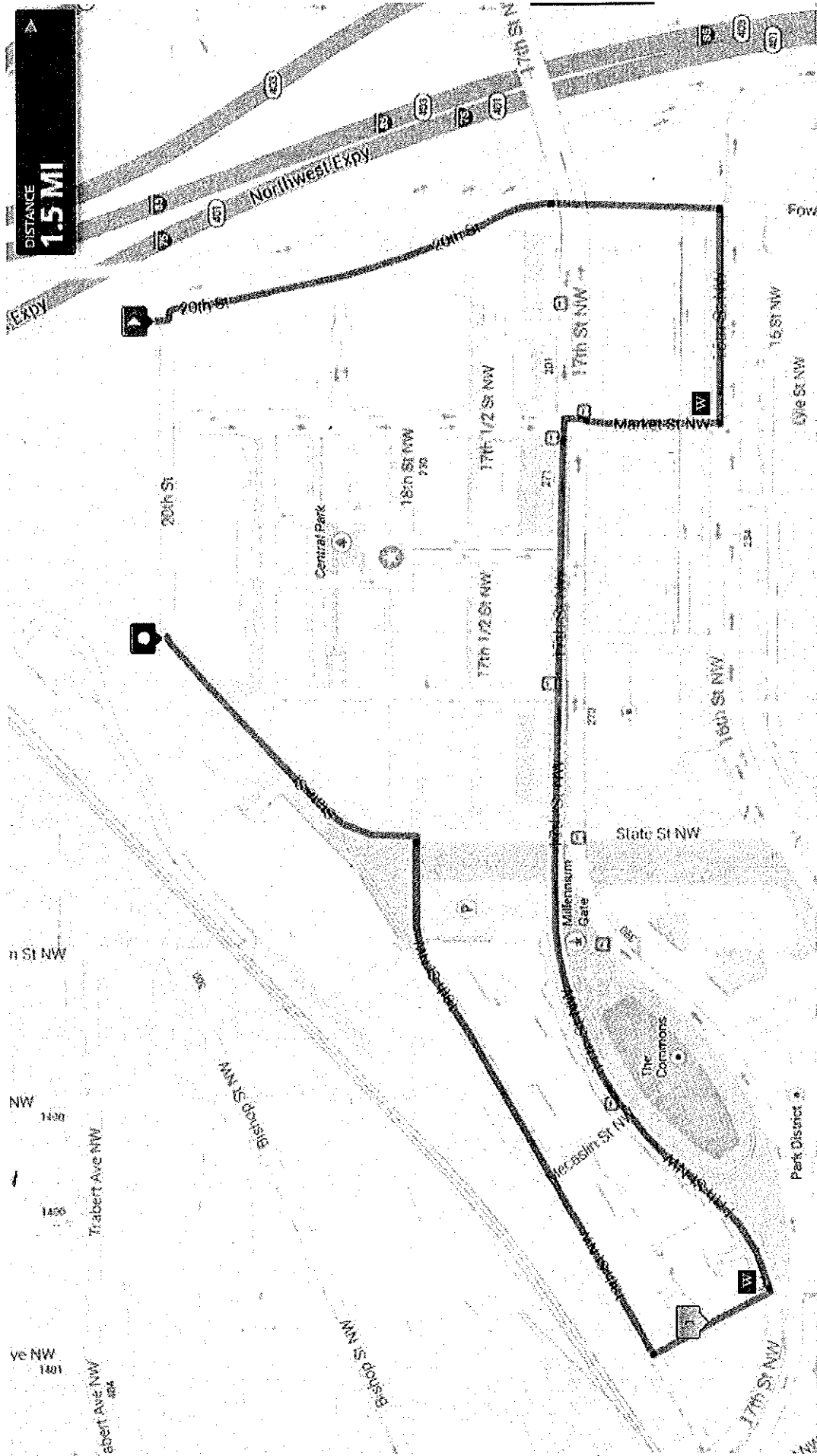
