



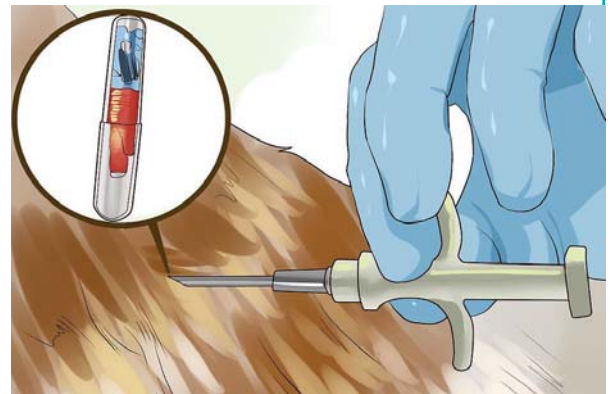

## MAKE A PET EMERGENCY PLAN

- ✓ Make sure your pet has an ID tag that is up to date. Include your phone number and the address of your evacuation site if possible.
- ✓ Consider microchipping your pets.
- ✓ Make sure that you have a current photo of your pet for identification purposes.
- ✓ Make a pet emergency kit.
- ✓ Identify shelters that allow pets. For public health reasons, many emergency shelters cannot accept pets.
- ✓ Make sure you have a secure pet carrier, leash or harness for your pet so that if he panics, he cannot escape.
