WINTER READY KIT FOR HOME & BUSINESS

- ❄️ Rock salt or more environmentally safe products to melt ice on walkways.
- ❄️ Sand to improve traction.
- ❄️ Snow shovels and other snow removal equipment.
- ❄️ Sufficient heating fuel. You may become isolated in your home and regular fuel sources may be cut off.
- ❄️ Store a good supply of dry, seasoned wood for your fireplace or wood-burning stove.
- ❄️ Adequate clothing and blankets to keep you warm.
- ❄️ **Water:** one gallon per person, per day for at least 3 days for drinking and sanitation.
- ❄️ **Food:** at least a 3 day supply of non-perishable food.
- ❄️ Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries.
- ❄️ Flashlight and extra batteries.
- ❄️ First-aid kit.
- ❄️ Whistle to signal for help.
- ❄️ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation.
- ❄️ Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities.
- ❄️ Manual can opener for food.
- ❄️ Local maps.
- ❄️ Cell phone with charger, inverter or solar chargers.
