

CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU Y: 2010 POPULATION


According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) Y is 11,111, a decrease of 1,361 (11%) from a 2000 population of 12,472.

The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU Y. NPU Y had an overall density of 5.3 persons per acre.




The population of NPU Y has a median age of the population of 32.4. Twenty-three percent of the population is under 18, 8% of the population is over 65 and 40% of the population is between 20 and 39 years




In 2000, NPU Y had a median age of 29.5. Six percent of the population was over 65 and 38% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.



RACE






Nineteen percent White, 72% Black, 3% Asian and 6% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and Other). Thirteen percent of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

HOUSEHOLDS






There are 8,687 NPU Y residents in 3,506 households. Of these, 53% are family households and 47% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 34% have children under age 18 and 22% have an individual 65 years and older.

Thirty-nine percent of households are single person households, with 13% being single person households over 65, 33% are female headed households and 14% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.48 persons per household and the average family size is 3.39 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 3,008 households in NPU Y, 51% of households had children under age 18 and 22% were single person households. The average household size was 3.25 persons per household.

2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU Y





Seventy-eight percent of NPU Y's population is in households, and 22% of the population lives in group quarters.
