


CITY OF ATLANTA – NPU T: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) T is 16,280, a decrease of 3,815 (19%) from a 2000 population of 20,095.

The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU T. NPU T has an overall density of 9.3 persons per acre.




The median age of the population is 23.3. Sixteen percent of the population is under 18, 9% of the population is over 65 and 35% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.






RACE





In 2000, the racial composition of NPU T was 97% Black, 1% White 0% Asian and 2% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and Other). One percent of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.



HOUSEHOLDS




There are 11,364NPU T residents in 5,030 households. Of these, 44% are family households and 56% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 25% have children under age 18 and 25% have an individual 65 years and older.

43% percent of households are single person households, with 13% being single person households over 65, 26% are female headed households and 13% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.26 persons per household and the average family size is 3.22 persons per family.

In 2000, of the 6,574 households in NPU T, 32% of households had children under age 18 and 38% were single person households. The average household size was 2.45 persons per household.


2010 Household and Group Quarter Population - NPU T




Seventy percent of NPU T's population can be found in households and 30% (4,916) live in group quarters



HOUSING



NPU T has 6,609 housing units, a decrease of of 779 (11%) housing units from 7,388 in 2000. 76% are occupied and 24% are vacant. Rental units have 17% vacancy rate while owner occupied units have a 12% vacancy rate.
