


CITY OF ATLANTA - NPU I: 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU) I is 21,208 a decrease of 292 (1.4%) from a 2000 population of 21,500.


The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in NPU I. NPU I has an overall density of 3.5 persons per acre.



AGE




The median age of the population is 40. 24% of the population is under 18, 20% of the population is over 65 and 24% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.




In 2000, NPU I had a median age of 37.8. 17% of the population was over 65, and 26% of the population was between 20 and 39 years old.



RACE




The racial composition of NPU I 94% Black, 2% White, 0% Asian, and 4% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other). 4% of the population is of Hispanic or Latin Origin.




In 2000, the racial composition of NPU I was 96% Black, 2% White, 0% Asian and 2% Other (Native American, Pacific Islander, two or more races and other). 6% of the population was of Hispanic or Latin Origin.

Householder

There are 21,201 NPU I residents in 8,654 households. Of these, 62% are family households and 38% are nonfamily households. Of all households, 30% have children under age 18 and 37% have an individual 65 years and older.

Single person households represent 33% of all households, with 14% being single person households over 65, 32% are female headed households and 23% are husband and wife households.


The average household size is 2.45 persons per household and the average family size is 3.1 persons per family.


In 2000, of the 8,312 households in NPU I, 34% had children under age 18 and 27% were single person households. The average household size was 2.58 persons per household.

100% of the NPU I population lives in households and 0% lives in Group Quarters.



HOUSING





Of the occupied housing units, 51% are owner occupied and 49% are renter occupied. In 2000, 59% of housing units were owner occupied while 41% were renter occupied.

Renter occupied units have 2.6 persons per households and owner occupied units have 2.3 persons per households.
