


CITY OF ATLANTA – Council District 7 - 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of the City of Atlanta Council District 7 is 36,296.


The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in District 7. District 7 has an overall density of 7.2 persons per acre.

The median age of the population is 35. Fifteen percent of the population is under 18, 12% of the population is over 65 and 43% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.




Seventy-seven percent of the population is White, 12% is African American, 6% is Asian, 3% is Other (Native American, Pacific Islander and Other) and 2% are two or more races. Seven percent of the population is of Hispanic or Latin Origin.


HOUSEHOLDS



There are 36,107 District 7 residents in 20,104 households. Of these, 35% are family households and 65% are non-family households. Of all households, 15% have children under age 18 and 17% have an individual 65 years and older.

Fifty-two percent of households are single person households, 4% are female headed households and 28% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 1.8 persons per household and the average family size is 2.8 persons per family.





Most of the District 7 population (99%) lives in households while 1% (189) live in Group Quarters.
