


### **CITY OF ATLANTA – Council District 3 - 2010 POPULATION**

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population of the City of Atlanta Council District 3 is 36,617.


The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in District 3. District 3 has an overall density of 7.6 persons per acre.

is 25.5. Twelve percent of the population is under 18, 6% of the population is over 65 and 42% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.



### **HOUSEHOLDS**




There are 25,624 District 3 residents in 12,183 households. Of these, 35% are family households and 65% are non-family households. Of all households, 18% have children under age 18 and 15% have an individual 65 years and older.

Forty-seven percent of households are single person households, 18% are female headed households and 12% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.1 persons per household and the average family size is 3.13 persons per family.

# Household and Group Quarters Population - Council District 3




Most of the District 3 population (70%) lives in households while 30% (10,993) live in Group Quarters.


Most of the Group Quarter population lives in Non-Institutionalized Group Quarters, mainly college and university housing.
