


CITY OF ATLANTA – Council District 1 - 2010 POPULATION

According to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population for the City of Atlanta Council District 1 is 33,600.


The Map shows the population density (persons per acre) of each Census Block in District 1. District 1 has an overall density of 5.2 persons per acre.

is 31.9. Twenty-five percent of the population is under 18, 6.3 % of the population is over 65 and 38% of the population is between 20 and 39 years old.




HOUSEHOLDS



There are 31,015 District 1 residents in 12,462 households. Of these, 54% are family households and 46% are non-family households. Of all households, 33% have children under age 18 and 14% have an individual 65 years and older.

Thirty-three percent of households are single person households, 27% are female headed households and 22% are husband and wife households.

The average household size is 2.49 persons per household and the average family size is 3.28 persons per family.



Most of the District 1 population (92%) lives in households while 8% (2,585) live in Group Quarters.


Almost all of the Group Quarter population lives in Institutionalized Group Quarters with Correctional facilities being the largest institutionalized group quarters.

Fifty-three percent of the occupied housing units are renter occupied and 47% are owner occupied. Renter occupied units have a larger household size (2.63) than owner occupied units (2.32).
