## What is the MMPT?

The Georgia MultiModal Passenger Terminal (MMPT) will bring together various ground and rail transit services in a centralized downtown Atlanta location, providing greater connectivity options to transit services that exist today, and will serve as a hub for future transit, including high-performance and commuter rail.

## What will be covered at the meeting?

The master development team will begin with a presentation that describes the requirements for various forms of transportation and provides an overview of the public involvement process. The presentation will then give the public a first look at design sketches detailing alternative footprints for the site of the proposed multimodal station. The public will have an opportunity to comment on the alternatives being presented. Featured speakers include:

- Rob Ross, Kimley-Horn and Associates Inc. (bus and transportation network)

## Directions to 72 Marietta St.

*Coming from the south* - Take I-75 downtown to the Central Avenue exit. Turn left on Decatur St., and cross Peachtree St. Decatur will turn into Marietta St.

*Coming from the north* - Take I-75 downtown to the Courtland St. exit and go straight, then right on Edgewood Avenue. Proceed through the Five Points intersection and merge onto Marietta St.

*Parking* - Parking is available in paid lots and decks adjacent to the building

*MARTA* - exit at Five Points MARTA Rail Station and go one block north to Marietta St.
