

SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

The following safety recommendations are taken from the Georgia Department of Transportation "Adopt-a-Highway" Rules and Regulations and the Department of Public Works Safety Division. All groups and individual volunteers are urged to consider them accordingly:

- 1. Hold safety meetings with group prior to litter pick-up activities.
- 2. Carpool to the litter pick-up area if possible to keep vehicles to a minimum.
- 3. Park vehicles away from the roadway.
- 4. Keep work group to a manageable size.
- 5. Closely supervise youth. Volunteers age 12 and under should be discouraged from collecting litter in streets.
- 6. Keep site of all your participants and be cognizant of surroundings.
- 7. Do not remove any hazardous materials found on the site.
- 8. Do not remove weapons or paraphernalia if found; immediately call 911.
- 9. Stay clear of construction areas.
- 10. Do not pick-up litter on bridges, overpasses or tunnels.
- 11. Do not pick-up litter during inclement weather, hours of darkness or hours of peak traffic.
- 12. Consider bringing plenty of water when working in hot temperatures and pace yourself.
- 13. Be aware of possible contact with poisonous plants, stinging insects, fire ants, snakes and rodents.
- 14. Consider the possibility of any participant's known allergies prior to litter pick-up.
- 15. Do not allow participants to partake of, possess or distribute alcohol beverages while involved in litter pick-up.
- 16. Make participants aware that they are working in a potentially dangerous environment and caution them to act accordingly.
- 17. Use gloves and protective clothing (safety vest, long sleeves and pants) and urge all participants to do so.
- 18. Never place your back towards traffic, always face traffic.
- 19. Safety cones may be required at certain pick-up locations.
- 20. Consider bringing a First Aid Kit to the pick-up location.
