# **CARING FOR OUR COURTS**



Clay courts are a rare find among public courts. City of Atlanta tennis players are fortunate to have this option available at Bitsy Grant Tennis Center where clay courts were recently resurfaced. We spoke with Mike Imbornone of Signature Tennis Courts to learn more about the advantages of resurfacing and how players can help maintain them. "Over time, a build-up occurs through cycles of freezing and thawing making parts of the court nonbondable," Mike explains. By design, clay courts are less stressful on a player's joints. Resurfacing brings the court to "optimal" condition. To help keep courts in tip-top shape, Mike recommends players "groom the court" after each use. Drag brooms are available near the fences to smooth the courts readying them for the next match. Consider it a form of court etiquette.
