Thank you for your continued support and interest in the City of Atlanta tennis centers. As we move into fall, interior and exterior facility improvements at each of the centers continues. Currently, crews are removing the existing railroad tie seat walls at Joseph McGhee and replacing them with block. New outdoor patio furniture and an ice machine will also be installed at McGhee Tennis Center. Interior painting, vegetation removal and tree pruning is now complete at Washington Tennis Center with additional tree pruning scheduled for the other centers. Contractors will begin painting at Sharon Lester, Bitsy Grant and Chastain and carpet is scheduled for replacement at Bitsy Grant. Additionally, a new ice machine is planned for Sharon Lester,

and we are reviewing estimates for hard court resurfacing. Even more exciting, Fall Leagues are underway at all City of Atlanta tennis centers! Although pickleball is only offered at Sharon Lester, we are exploring the option of making this sport available at other locations. The cooler months provide ideal opportunities for platform tennis at Bitsy Grant Tennis Center. With winter approaching, we have received numerous requests concerning the use of our indoor tennis facilities. However, due to COVID-19 guidelines, use remains limited. We will keep you up to date as changes occur. As always, thank you for sharing your feedback with us. We look forward to seeing you at the centers soon!
