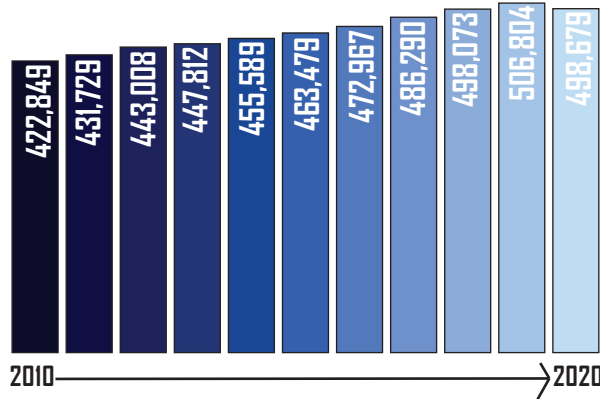


AT A GLANCE: CITY OF ATLANTA

POPULATION

Atlanta, GA has a population of 498,679 people with a median age of 35 and a median household income of \$58,473. Between 2010 and 2020 the population grew from 420,003 to 498,679, a 1.19% increase, and it's median income grew from \$41,631 to \$58,473, a represents a 1.40% increase

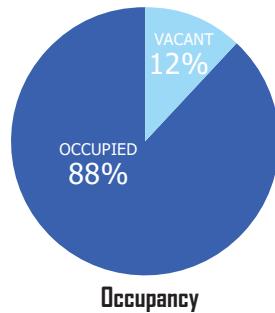
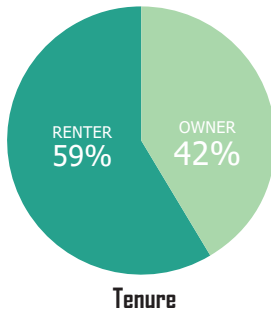


The poverty level in the City is 20%. This is down 6.1% from the 2010 level of 26.1%.

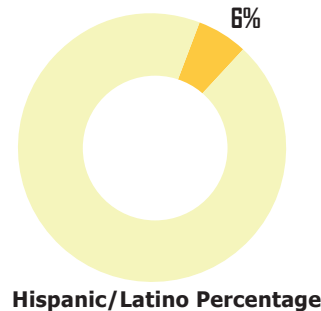
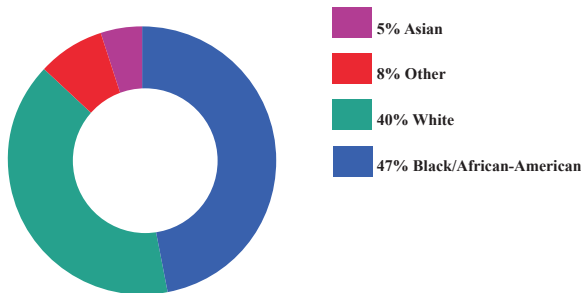
The racial composition of Atlanta, GA is 47% Black, 40% White, 5% Asian and 8% other.

This median property value is \$331,575 a 4.34% increase from 2010 and the home ownership rate is 42%. Most structures in Atlanta are one unit detached and the most popular mode of transportation is driving alone.

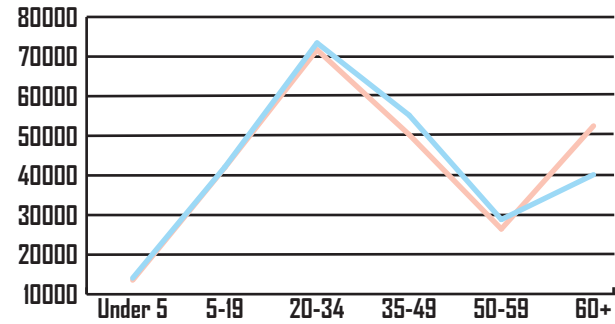

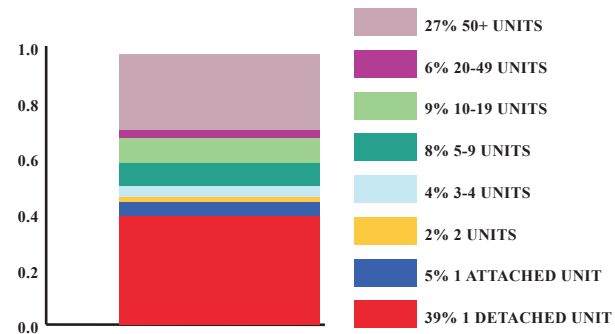
RACE AND ETHNICITY



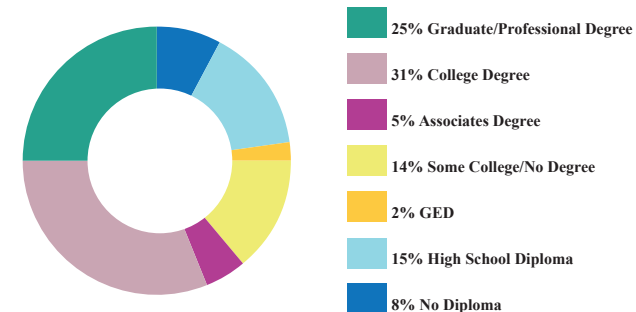
AGE BY GENDER
