1. Lifeguard Summer Employment Opportunity

- c. Programming varies by location. Reach out to participating centers for more information.

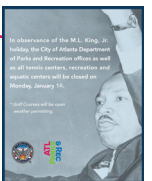
8. Prime Time Seniors Programming
