Trees on Private Property

The City of Atlanta Arborist Division, Office of Buildings within the Department of City Planning is charged with protecting the City's tree canopy on private property throughout the City.

Examples of issues that may be reported to the Arborist Division (Office of Buildings):

- Potential illegal removal of a tree.
- Tree save fence is down or improperly placed during construction.
- Potential destruction of trees during construction.

Trees on Public Property

Department oversees permitting of trees on

public property and in the City right-of-way

(which is typically the space between sidewalks

and the street or the space where a sidewalk

could be placed if not present).

Examples of issues that may be reported to the Arborist Division (Parks and Recreation):

- Dead, dying, or hazardous trees on public land.
- Potential illegal removal or destruction of trees on public land.
- Tree save fence is down or improperly placed during construction on public land.
- Potential destruction of trees on public land during construction.
