- 5. **Appeal Hearing**. Schedule. We have only one hearing this month (September 18, 2024, 6:30 pm). Confirm attendance.
- 6. **Atlanta's Native Forest 2025** calendar preparation underway. To Be printed by mid-December.
- 7. **Canopy Analysis.** 2024 quantitative analysis underway. We are in midst of conducting site visits for qualitative analysis, over 100 sites.
- 8. **Quarterly Reports**. Dashboard not yet finalized. Issues with compatibility of PowerBI. Discuss reinitiating contract to map permits and clean data.
- 9. Tree Ordinance update.
  - Phase 2,Tree Ordinance update meetings took place at least twice a month during the first half of the year, with some committees meeting more often. Sent summary of Work Sessions and schedule to draft the updates last week. Follow-up meetings with staff are underway. City Council has requested a draft in fall, to be finalized by the end of the year.
