

Connect Atlanta Plan: Progress Report



The Office of Planning is in the process of developing technical corrections to the City's Connect Atlanta Plan. These technical corrections will incorporate the city's recent transportation planning work efforts completed as a part of the 2012 Regional Transportation Referendum community outreach effort and project recommendations from recently adopted transportation studies and plans.

The goal is to ensure that the current plan provides accurate project information and projects recommendations from recently adopted Livable Centers Initiatives and neighborhood plans are included for use as funding become available to implement these improvements.

The Office of Planning will host an information session to present a progress report. A brief overview of the process and the list of **Connect Atlanta Plan** projects will be included as a part of the session.
