

Candler Park's Fall Fest 5K Road Race

This year's Fall Fest 5K Road Race will take place on Saturday, September 28th at 10 AM. Runners will receive one FREE beer and a comfy 5k shirt. You will also be able to pick up your packet on the day of the race at Epworth Methodist Church starting at 8:30 AM.

This year's race will begin on Page Ave just north of McLendon Ave. Both lanes of Page Ave will be shut down from 9 AM to approximately 10:15 AM. In addition, the following roads will be affected:

Marlbrook between Page Ave and Clifton Rd
Clifton avenue between Marlbrook and Clifton Terrace
Clifton Terrace between Clifton and Candler Park Dr
Both lanes of Oakdale Rd from North Ave to Fairview Rd will be closed from 10 AM to 11 AM
Fairview Rd between Springdale Rd and S. Ponce De Leon Ave
S. Ponce De Leon Ave between Springdale Rd and Fairview Rd
North Ave between Euclid Ave and Candler Park Dr
Benning Pl between Candler Park Dr and Oakdale Rd
Miller Ave between Oakdale Rd and Candler Park Dr
Oakdale Rd between Benning Pl and McLendon Ave
Miller Ave between Oakdale Rd and Candler Park Dr

The race will finish on Candler Park Dr and all of the runners will enter the festival via the sidewalk that leads to the swimming pool. Please come join the fun as a volunteer or spectator.

The volunteers will receive a 5k shirt for helping make it happen.
